	26.05.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s – 482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely 1. Ranjan Kumar, aged about 24 years S/o- Ram Kumar Mandal, 2. Raman Kumar aged about 20 years S/o- Domi Mandal Both R/o Village- Dhaushi, PS.- Phulparas , District Madhubani, in connection with Phulparas P.S case No- 05/2026, Gr.No.-15/2026, U/s- 25(1-B)A, 26/35 of Arms Act. 2. Heard Sri Nageshwar Yadav for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent, have not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been stated that there is one case against Ranjan Kumar and no other criminal case against Raman Kumar. It was also submitted that the petitioners are local man and there is no chance of their absconding, if they be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioners on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case is that One A.S.I Niranjan Kumar given a written petition before S.H.O Phulparas and stated in that on 03.01.2026 at about 20:10 got secret information that petitioner accused and his friend were seating with weapons at northern bank of Balan River. We left the police station for verification of the information and to take necessary action. When I reached there three boys tried to run away out of which one boy was caught he told his name as Nitish Kumar and two other was Krishna Kumar & Raman Kumar. We have searched that place and a loaded country made pistol was recovered, upon unloading a live cartridge was recovered, two mobile phones was	

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	cont. 26.05.2026	recovered, A seizure list was prepared and seized for the seized items. And signature was taken of the arrested petitioner on seizure list. Nitish Kumar stated that Ranjan had given them this weapon when he was going to Delhi. Earlier I, Ranjan, Krishna, Raman & two others criminals have looted 5 vehicles on gunpoint at N.H.27 near Garatol, Sijauliya, Brahampur & Siswar and all vehicle sold to Manish resident of Suatol. Nitish told that he had previously been jailed for wine case and vehicle theft case. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, LCR, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that one illegal country made pistol and cartridges have been supplied by this petitioner to accused Nitish Kumar. Accused Raman Kumar had also fled away with Ranjan Kumar seeing police. The witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para 3,4,5,6,7 of case diary and petitioner Ranjan Kumar has one criminal antecedent. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and seeing the serious nature of allegation the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely1. Ranjan Kumar and 2.
