	08.07.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s – 482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely 1. Upendra Prasad Mahato aged about 37 years S/o- Munilal Mahato 2. Mamta Devi aged about 34 years W/o- Upendra Mahato 3. Munilal Mahato aged about 50 years S/o- Late Ramnandan Mahato 4. Jamuna Devi aged about 56 years W/o- Munilal Mahato All R/o Vill- Rupauli, P.S.- Lakhnaur, District- Madhubani in connection with Lakhanour P.S case No- 101/2024 Gr.No.-1259/2024 U/s- 126(2),115(2),76,303(2),3(5) of BNS. 2. Heard Sri Hari Narayan Yadav for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent, have not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that petitioners have no criminal antecedents. It was also submitted that the petitioners are local and there is no chance of their absconding, if they be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioners on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in brief is that accused Munilal Mahto asbestos put on the animal Gohali and said to the informant to the accused persons, then the accused Munilal Mahto assaulted to the wife of the informant and all the accused persons assaulted to them and snatching Mangalsutra from neck. It is further stated that mobile of Rupees 15000/- stolen. 6. Perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, LCR and submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record, I find that there is allegation against the petitioners to assault informant and his family members. On further perusal I	

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	cont. 08.07.2026	find that petitioners have filed bond U/s 35(3) of BNSS and the nature of injury is simple. Further I find that police have submitted charge sheet against the petitioners. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. Upendra Prasad Mahato 2. Mamta Devi 3. Munilal Mahato and 4. Jamuna Devi, are hereby allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender by the petitioner within 21 days of the receipt/production of the order, they are directed to be released on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned with an undertaking under section 482(2) of BNSS .
