ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition filed under section 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of the above named petitioner **Vishwamitra Jha** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Madhepur P.S. Case No. 84/2026** for the offence **under section 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 351(2), 352 of BNS** which is pending in the court of Miss Sikha Kumari, JM-Ist, Jhanjharpur is being pressed and heard.

The case of the prosecution in nutshell, on the basis of typed application of the informant Sudhir Jha is that on 03.04.2026 at about 2 PM, he was returning from the dam, after grazing the buffaloes. On the way, Vishwamitra Jha stopped him due to land dispute, and started abusing him. When he protested, he assaulted him with iron rod, severely splitting his head with iron rod, with the intention of killing him. When he fell on the ground, he attacked other parts of his body, with the same rod, injuring him badly. Vishwamitra threatened him, and said that he had beaten your brother before, and that no one could harm him. He added that if you go to the police station to file a case, he will kill him. When some people gathered nearby, and his mother arrived, they brought him to the Primary Health Center in Madhepur for treatment, where his condition worsened. A total of nine

stitches were applied to the head, and the injury to the right hand was also treated. Hence, this case.

Learned Counsel of petitioner accused has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent. The prosecution story is totally false, fabricated, concocted, and baseless. The petitioner is falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village party politics. No any occurrence has taken place. The land dispute is admitted between the parties. Due to revenge, and past grudge, this false case has been registered against innocent person. The petitioner is a student, and doing study outside of the village. Accordingly, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the accused petitioner.

Learned APP had opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail. Witnesses in para-2, 3, and 4 had completely corroborated the case. Injury sustained by injured though simple in nature, but the same is a cut wound on head 5 cm*2mm. Allegation on petitioner is quite specific in the FIR. Moreover, investigation is still pending. Considering these facts, this Court is not inclined to give privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Hence, anticipatory bail petition of petitioner **Vishwamitra Jha** is hereby **rejected**.
