Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Vikash Singh aged about 21 years S/o- Chandra Prakash Singh, R/o-Village- Sijaul, PS.- Andharathari ,District Madhubani, in connection with Andharathari P.S Case No- 32/2026 Gr.No.-377/2026, U/s-25(1-B)(a),26 of Arms Act. 2. Heard Sri Vijay Kumar Mandal learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular bail petition has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been stated that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 28.02.2026. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on 27.02.2026 at around 7:30 PM, an student who was brandishing a pistol during the University Sandeep Utsav as soon as he saw Police, dropped the pistol and ran away taking advantage of the darkness. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to possess pistol. On further perusal I find that petitioner is in custody since 28.02.2026 and police have submitted charge sheet in this case and petitioner has no criminal antecedent. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody, the petitioner Vikash Singh is	

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15.05.2026	directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, with an undertaking under section 437 (3) Cr.P.C, to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned and with further condition that the petitioner will not be involved in case of similar nature in future and will co-operate in investigation.
