Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Surya Kumar @ Tuntun Kumar, S/o- Mukti Lal Yadav, aged about- 20 years R/o Village- Murli, P.S- Phulparas, District Madhubani, in connection with Jhanjharpur P.S Case No- 126/2025, Gr.No.-1263/2025, U/s- 309(6) of BNS. 2. Heard Sri Hari Narayan Yadav learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular bail petition has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further submitted that petitioner has no criminal history. He has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 03.01.2026. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case according to Informant is that on 29.06.2025 at about 10:40 PM the petitioner and other accused assaulted him and snatched his Apache motorcycle and Rs 800 from his pocket on NH27. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to snatch Apache motorcycle and Rs 800 from the pocket of informant. On further perusal of case record I find that the petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2026 and charge sheet have already been submitted by police. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody, the petitioner Surya Kumar @ Tuntun Kumar is directed to be released on bail on furnishing	

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	cont. 22.04.2026	bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, with an undertaking under section 437 (3) of Cr.P.C, to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned and with further condition that the petitioner will not be involved in case of similar nature in future and will co-operate in trial.
