This anticipatory bail petition filed on 27.01.2026 under section 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of the above named petitioners **1. Lalan Thakur, & 2. Sumanjee Thakur** who are apprehending his arrest in connection with **Madhepur P.S. Case No. 11/2026, G.R. No. 97/2026** for the offence **under section 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109(1), 76, 305, 351(2), 352, 352, 3(5) of B.N.S.**, which is pending in the court of Smt. Shikha Kumari, J.M.1st Class, Jhanjharpur, is being pressed and heard.

According to the FIR, the informant of this case is Maheshwari Devi, and she has stated that on 11.01.2026 at 08:00 AM, his neighbours named in F.I.R and other persons, in collusion, came to his house armed with iron rods, sickles, sticks, and other sharp weapons and started beating his two sons Santosh Thakur and Ashok Thakur and his daughter-in-law mercilessly. Ramanji Thakur tried to dishonour his daughter-in-law and after throwing her on the ground, opened her saree and blouse, due to which her daughter-in-law became naked, and her modesty was violated. When his sons came to rescue her, Sumanji Thakur and Lalanji Thakur together attacked him on the head with a stick, due to which his head got cracked, started bleeding, and he became unconscious. Also, due to beating with stick and fist, his chest bone got broken. Since his son is in the tent

business, and the above-mentioned people always demand extortion, enraged by this, they attacked her. Sumanji Thakur snatched Rs. 25,000/- and a gold chain from his son's pocket. Ramsakhi Devi entered the house, and fled with a tin box containing important documents etc. Hence, this case.

Learned counsel for the accused petitioner submitted that no bail petition has been filed by the petitioner earlier either in the Court of Ld. Sessions Judge, Madhubani, or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner is quite innocent, and has not committed any offence. The prosecution story is false, concocted, absurd, and no occurrence did ever take place as alleged against the petitioner. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has no criminal antecedents. It is further stated that this false case has been lodged by the informant in order to save her self from dire-consequences from Madhepur P.S Case No. 10/2026 lodged by Ram Sakhi who is the mother of the petitioners. That all offences are bailable except u/s- 109(1), 76 B.N.S which is added only to make the case non-bailable and graver. Accordingly, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

Learned APP had opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument and perused the case diary. Witnesses in para-2, 3, 8, 24 and 25 of case diary, had completely supported the occurrence. Moreover, it appears from statement of witnesses that petitioners were aggressors, and there is specific allegation against the petitioners. Injury sustained by injured is on right side of parietal region, which is on vital part of the body, and final injury report is still awaited. Process u/s 82 Cr.P.C has been issued against the petitioners. Moreover, the case is still under investigation. Considering these facts, this Court is not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Hence, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners namely **Lalan Thakur, & Sumanjee Thakur** are **rejected**.
