This is the anticipatory bail application U/s –482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused person Shamsul Nadaf, S/o- Bachu Nadaf, aged about- 25 years R/o Village -Fataki, PS.- Madhepur ,District Madhubani, in connection with Lakhanour P.S case No- 02/2026 Gr.No.-22/2026 , U/s- 126(2),318(4),179,351(2) of BNS. 2. Heard Sri Lakshmi Kant Singh for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It was also submitted that the petitioner is local man and there is no chance of his absconding, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on that on 21.12.2025 between 4:30 to 7 PM the petitioner accused bought a buffalo from informant America Devi and given her duplicate currency of Rs. 70000/-. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and find that there is allegation against the petitioner to give duplicate currency of Rs. 70000/- to informant America Devi and test report of fake currency is still awaited. Further the witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para 6,7 and 8 of case diary and investigation is going
