This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely, <b>1.Nilam Devi, 2.Ram Sewak Yadav, and 3.Ravindra Kumar Yadav</b>, seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Lakhanour P.S case No- 54/2026, Gr.No.- 697/2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 74, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS.</p> <p>2. Heard <b>Sri Rajeev Kumar Jha</b> Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioners, and <b>Sri Indrakant Prasad</b>, learned APP for the state.</p> <p>3. Ld. counsel of the petitioners has submitted that no any bail petition has been filed by petitioners before this Court, or Hon'ble High Court of Patna. It is further submitted that petitioners are quite innocent, and have not committed any offence. Prosecution story is totally false, vague, concocted, and that no occurrence as alleged ever took place. That one of the petitioner Nilam Devi has also lodged a counter case i.e. Lakhanour PS. Case No. 58/26 against the informant, and from perusal of FIR sections 109 and 74 are not made out against the petitioners. It is further submitted that the informant as well as the petitioners are the family member, and petitioner No.2 is the real brother of the informant. Lastly he has submitted that petitioners are apprehending their arrest in this case, and Ld. Counsel prays to allow the anticipatory bail.</p> <p>4. The learned APP had opposed the petition, and prayed to reject it.</p> <p>5. The prosecution story in brief is that, informant of this case is Ram Udgar Yadav and he has alleged that on 24.03.2026 at about 3 P.M., the accused persons named in FIR were fencing the tat in the land of the informant. When informant protested, then they started abusing the informant. Ram Sevak Yadav directed to kill him. Ravindra Kumar Yadav attacked the informant with iron rod due to which his left leg was fractured, and Ram Sevak attacked the informant with iron rod on head, but when informant tried to save, he sustained injury on his left hand. Ravindra Kumar Yadav also assaulted the informant with his leg, and when informant's wife came</p> |                                 |

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to rescue, then Nilam Devi attacked with iron rod due to which informant's wife sustained injury on her right leg. Ram Sevak Yadav and Ravindra Kumar Yadav tried to outrage the modesty of informant's wife. Later all accused named in FIR assaulted them with iron rod. The injured persons were treated at DMCH. Hence, this case.

6. Heard and perused the case diary. Perusal of para-15 of case diary shows that petitioner no-2 and 3 have one criminal antecedent. From the statement of witnesses, it is quite clear that informant, and petitioner no-2 are own brothers, and there is a dispute between both sides regarding share in land. Also, T.S-326/24 is going on between both sides. Petitioner Nilam Devi had also filed Lakhnour P.S case no-58/26 on informant, and others. From para-38 of case diary, police had sent for proceeding u/s 126 BNSS. It has also come out from statement of witnesses that when petitioners were erecting fence, it is the informant who went there to stop petitioners. Moreover, injury sustained by injured are though grievous in nature, but is on their respective legs, and the same is not on vital part of the body. Considering the aforesaid facts, as well as discussion made above, the Anticipatory Bail Petition of the petitioners accused namely **Nilam Devi, Ram Sewak Yadav, and Ravindra Kumar Yadav** is hereby **allowed**. It is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the court below/concerned police within 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) BNSS.
