This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely, Shiv Kumar Singh who is under custody since 16.04.2026, in connection with Andhara Thari P.S Case No- 110/2025, U/s- 103(1) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Rajeev Kumar Jha, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioner and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioners Sri Rajeev Kumar Jha has submitted that eariler no any bail petition has been filed by petitioner either before this Court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna and petitioner has one criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence and the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this false case with ulterior motive and the prosecution story is totally false, vague and concocted. It is also submitted that no occurrence as alleged did ever took place and there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. It is also submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case on the basis of confessional statement of one of the co-accused Jitendra Singh and this confessional statement was recorded before the police which is under threat and undue influence. Lastly, it is submitted that petitioner is under custody since 16.04.2026, Ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed to reject it.

The case of prosecution in brief is that on the basis of self statement of Rahul Kumar SI SHO Andhrathari P.S., recorded on dated 24.07.2025 at Andhrathari P.S. at 08:05 AM, and it is alleged that on 24.07.2025 at about 02:25 AM, he got an information about commitment of dacoity in the house of Raj Kumar Sah at village Sahuriya, when he reached at the place of occurrence, he saw household articles are scattered there and a person was found dead at the field of Raj Kumar Sah, who was injured and it is found that he was murdered by using fire arms and at that time no body came to identify the dead person. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at the length and perused the case record along with LCR and case diary available. From perusal of the record it transpires that on the basis of self statement of Rahul Kumar SI SHO Andhrathari P.S., recorded on dated 24.07.2025 at Andhrathari P.S. at 08:05 AM, this case has been registered against unknown persons under section 103(1) of the BNS. It is alleged in the FIR that on 24.07.2025 at about 02:25 AM, the informant got information about commitment of dacoity in the house of Raj Kumar Sah at village Sahuriya, when he reached at the place of occurrence, he saw household articles are scattered there and a person was found dead at the field of Raj Kumar Sah, who was injured and it is found that he was murdered by using fire arms and at that time no body came to identify the dead person. From perusal of the case diary it transpires that the witnesses in para No. 3 & 4 have supported the case of the prosecution and in inquest report as per para No. 07 of the case diary, the victim was

Apart from that the witnesses in para No. 11, 12, 13 and 14 have also supported the case of the prosecution. From perusal of para No. 42 of the case diary, the name of this petitioner accused come into picture on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Kamlesh Kumar Singh which was recorded in course of investigation and the name of the deceased was disclosed as Pradeep Kumar Sah @ Manoj and in supervision recorded in para No. 47 of the case diary, the case is found true against the petitioner accused and others and in para No. 49 of the case diary, the postmortem report of the victim is described, in which entry wound is found in right side of the chest 4 cm lateral to midline between 7th to 9th ribs, size 0.5” x 0.5” circular in shape abraded collar present and cause of death is due to hemorrhage and shock caused by gun shot. 7. Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances discussed above and seriousness of offence, gravity and nature of offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.
