	17.06.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely 1.Raso Devi 2.Jhunar Devi @ Rina Devi, seeking pre arrest bail in connection with Khutauna P.S. Case No. 51/2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109(1), 303(2), 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Raj Kumar Yadav, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned A.P.P. for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioners has submitted that no other bail petition has earlier been filed either in this Court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna and petitioners have no criminal antecedent. He has further submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence and prosecution story is totally false, absurd and concocted. It is further submitted that no case is made out against the petitioner and there was inordinate delay in lodging the FIR. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners and all the petitioners are pardanasin ladies. Lastly he has submitted that petitioners are apprehending their arrest in this case, and ld. Counsel prays to allow the anticipatory bail. 4. The learned A.P.P opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The informant of this case is Suresh Kumar Ram and the case of the prosecution in brief is that on 27.03.2026 at 07:30 P.M. the father of the informant along with the family were sitting at the doorstep then due to previous enmity all the accused persons named in the FIR along with 2-3 unknown persons came at the doorstep and Parmeshwar Ram assaulted the father of the informant with Dabiya due to which he sustained head injury and he fell to the ground and became unconscious. When informant came to rescue then Vinod Ram and Bipin Ram assaulted with iron rod on the head and blood oozed out from mouth and nose. Vinod Ram snatched Rs. 12,000/- and a golden Hanuman Ji from the neck weight eight aana. When	

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contd. 17.06.2026	informant's wife Kavita Devi came to rescue then Binod Ram hit on the body due to which she sustained injury and fell down. In the meantime Avinash Kumar Ram came and pulled the hair of informant's wife, dragged her, tore the blouse and made her half naked. Raso Devi snatched golden mangalsutra and when informant's cousin brother Arjun Kumar came to rescue then Mithilesh Ram hit him with iron rod due to which he sustained injury on right side of the head. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both side at length on this instant anticipatory bail petition and perused the case record along with case diary available. From perusal of the record it appears that on the basis of the application given by the informant victim before SHO Khutauna P.S., this case has been registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109(1), 303(2), 3(5) of the BNS against the petitioners and other co-accused persons. As per allegation alleged in the FIR due to previous enmity accused petitioners and other co-accused persons forming unlawful assembly came into the doorstep of the informant and assaulted to the father of the informant and others due to that the father of the informant died in course of treatment. As far as the allegation of assault is concerned which is not against the petitioners rather the main allegation of assault is against the Parmeshwar Ram who is not the petitioner in this bail petition. From perusal of the FIR itself no any kind of accusation is against the petitioners accused save and except omnibus and general allegation of theft against the petitioner No. 01 which is omnibus and general in nature. Apart from that there is a case and counter case exists in between the parties. Further from perusal of para No. 06, 07 and 55 of the case diary, the witnesses have also not supported the allegation of theft as alleged against petitioner No.01. Apart from that petitioners have got clean antecedent. 7. Therefore, considering aforesaid facts discussed above as well as general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners and petitioners are ladies, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners namely, 1.Raso Devi 2.Jhunar Devi @ Rina Devi on anticipatory bail. Therefore, in the event of their arrest

Court below within a period of 21 days from receipt of this order, petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld.
