Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Kishori Jha aged about 43 years S/o- Mishri Jha, R/o-Village- Malin Belha, PS.- Laukaha, District Madhubani, in connection with Laukaha P.S Case No- 283/2021 Gr.No.-1490/2021, U/s- 341,323,324,325,307,504 of IPC. 2. Heard Sri Bipin Kumar Jha, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that ABP No. 491/21 was rejected after that the petitioner filed his anticipatory bail before Hon'ble High Court, Patna, Cr. Misc. No. 24786/22 and after bearing the same was rejected again the petitioner earlier filed his anticipatory bail ABP No. 466/22 on fresh ground (compromise) and after hearing the same was rejected and now no any bail petition either regular or anticipatory has earlier been filed or pending in any superior Court. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further stated that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It has further been stated that informant died on dated 10.11.2022 and the instant case has been compromised with his son Ajay Kumar Jha and a separate photo copy of the death Certificate of the informant Late Brahmdev Jha also filed along with this bail petition vide Annexure.1. It has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 26.04.2026. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on on 17.08.2021 at about 02:30 PM he was sitting at his door and was talking with his villager Bidya Nand Jha when Kishori Jha came having Fathha in his hand and started abusing him. When the informant prohibited him from abusing, then with intention to kill he started assaulting him indiscriminately. When the accused assaulted on head, the informant tried to catch the fathha with his hand and because of this, his finger got injured near nail and blood started oozing. When the informant was again assaulted on his head, he tried to ward off his attack with his right hand but his right hand got broken and he fell down. At this, Kishori Jha climbed on his chest and started assaulting him on his chest with brick. Because of this, his shoulder and rib got broken. On informant's hue and cry nearby people

	21.05.2026	started coming and then the accused took 340 rupees from informant's pocket and fled away. While going the accused said that today he got saved otherwise he might have been killed. The informant was brought to Khutauna PHC for treatment. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to assault informant. On further perusal I find that petitioner is in custody since 26.04.2026 and police have submitted chargesheet against the petitioner. Moreover the the petitioner has clean antecedent and this case has been compromised. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody, the petitioner Kishori Jha is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, with an undertaking under section 437 (3) Cr.P.C, to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned and with further condition that the petitioner will not be involved in case of similar nature in future and will co-operate in investigation.
