	03.06.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s –482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely 1. Bhuneshwar Das aged about 47 years S/o- Phuleshwar Das 2. Raman Kumar aged about 24 years S/o- Bhuneshwar Das 3. Aman Kumar aged about 20 year S/o- Maheshwar Das 4. Maheshwar Das aged about 46 Years S/o- Phuleshwar Das 5. Rameshwar Das aged about 55 years S/o- Phuleshwar Das 6. Rakesh Das aged about 28 years S/o- Rameshwar Das 7. Raslal Das aged about 44 years S/o- Khusilal Das 8. Raja Kumar aged about 20 years S/o- Raslal Das 9. Ranjit Das aged about 26 years S/o- Ramchandra Das 10. Bhavesh Das aged about 32 years S/o- Bahuri Das 11. Mukesh Das aged about 26 years S/o- Rameshwar Das 12. Heard Sri Shiv Kumar Jha for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent, have not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. He has further submitted that petitioners have one criminal antecedent. It was also submitted that the petitioners are local man and there is no chance of their absconding, if they be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case according to informant in short is that on 04.03.2026 at about 5 PM on the occasion of Holi , all the people made a consensus among themselves regarding the old enmity all the named accused together, with the intention of beating and looting, armed with Lathi, iron rods, pistols, broke my main gate with the intention of committing robbery , entered inside and Bhuneshwar Das, hit Shyam Sundar Das on his forehead with a sharp axe, Rakesh Das, broke my both hands	

	cont. 03.06.2026	with a rod. Maheshwar Das, disrobed me. All the above named accused entered Shivtosh Das's shop, entered my house and looted a gold Mangalsutra and a silver anklet. They destroyed 5 motorcycles and broke the glass of a pickup truck. They broke the trunk and looted Rs. 1,50,000 in cash. All the above men destroyed 42 pieces of asbestos which is on the roof of my house. They took away two mobile phones from my house and broke and destroyed a Dhankutiya machine when my mother in law came to save me, Hanumanji Das hit her with a rod and broke her right hand and injured her. The injured was picked up and brought to the Sub Divisional Hospital, Phulparas and later referred to DMCH, Darbhanga. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to assault informant and his family members with lathi, axe and iron rod. The witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para 5 and 9 of case diary and investigation is going on. The opinion regarding injury report is reserved. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and seeing the serious nature of allegation the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. Bhuneshwar Das, 2. Raman Kumar , 3. Aman Kumar, 4. Maheshwar Das ,5. Rameshwar Das , 6. Rakesh Das , 7. Raslal Das , 8. Raja Kumar, 9. Ranjit Das , 10. Bhavesh Das , 11. Mukesh Das , 12. Amarjit Das stands rejected.
