	09.06.2026	1. This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely Md. Ataul Rahman @ Md. Ataur Rahman, who is under custody since 24.04.2026, in connection with Arariya Sangram P.S Case No- 29/2026, U/s-115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Rishi Kumar Jha, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioner and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioner Sri Rishi Kumar Jha has submitted that earlier no other bail petition either before this Court of before Hon'ble High Court has been filed and petitioner has two criminal antecedents. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to grudge, malice and land dispute. It is also submitted that the prosecution story is false and concocted and no occurrence as alleged has ever been taken place and there is a land dispute in between the parties and for that Title Suit is pending bearing No. 53/23. It is also submitted that there is no any specific allegation of assault against the petitioner and no case is made out U/s 109, 118(1) of the BNS against the petitioner. Lastly it is submitted that petitioner is under custody since 24.04.2026, ld. counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that the informant of this case is Md.	

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Contd... 09.06.2026	Jiyauddin, he has alleged that on 22.04.2026 at 06:30 PM when he was returning from market, all the accused persons named in FIR including this petitioner armed with farsa, iron rod, lathi etc. surrounded him and started abusing and accused petitioner and co-accused Md. Nizam and Md. Sakib Caught the informant and other accused namely Md. Shamsher assaulted to the informant with intention to kill by means of farsa, resulted informant sustained injury and other co-accused Md. NIyaj took Rs. 15000/-. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at length and perused the record including case diary and injury report. From perusal of the record it transpires that on the basis of written application given by Md. Jiyauddin, informant before SHO Arariya Sangram, this case has been registered U/s-115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS against the petitioner and others. As per allegation it is alleged that due to land dispute, accused petitioner and others surrounded the informant having deadly weapons like farsa, danda, lathi etc. and in-course of that accused petitioner and co-accused Md. Nizam and Md. Sakib Caught the informant and other accused namely Md. Shamsher assaulted to the informant with intention to kill by means of farsa, resulted informant sustained injury and other co-accused Md. Niyaj took Rs. 15000/-. From perusal it also transpires that there is a land dispute and enmity in between the parties and petitioner is still behind the bar since 24.04.2026 for about 1 ½ months inspite of that from perusal of injury report of the informant Md.

Jiyauddin, which is found simple in nature caused by hard blunt object and no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner.

7. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts as discussed above, as well as detention period of the petitioner and injury found simple in nature, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, namely **Md. Ataul Rahman @ Md. Ataur Rahman**, on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of Ld. Court below.
