	17.07.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s –482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely Rayazullah @ Md. Riyajullah @ Raju S/o- Late Anul Hak aged about 61 years, resident of Vill.- Batermari, Basudeopur, P.S- Laukaha , Dist- Madhubani in connction with Laukaha P.S case No- 226/2020 Gr.No.-1511/2020, U/s- 147, 148, 149, 302, 307, 323, 324, 341, 504 of IPC 2. Heard Sri Bipin Kumar Jha for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further stated that petitioner is not FIR named accused and during investigation and supervision the police filed the charge sheet also against the petitioner and the lower Court took cognizance on dated 31.10.2023 agaisnt the petitioner and it is further stated that the petitioner brother Md. Rijaulah was the FIR named accused and after the death of the brother Md. Rijaulah, the police made accused of the petitioner. It has further stated that the petitioner would not came in the purview of 302 & 307 of IPC andailable offences which are ornamental and only to make grievous of the offences. It was further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. It has further submitted that petitioner has no any criminal antecedent. It was also submitted that the petitioner is local man and there is no chance of his absconding, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on dated 12.08.2020 all the named accused persons and some unknown accused persons assaulted his father namely Md. Yusuf by various arms like Lathi, Dabiya, Farsa & iron rod and it has been alleged by the informant that Md. Nasir assaulted by means of Dabiya and Md. Manjur Alam by means of iron rod and Md. Ajruddin by means

From perusal of the case record, case diary, LCR, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record, I find that name of petitioner has surfaced in this case on the basis of cognizance order dated 31.10.2023 taken by SDJM, Jhanjharpur in GR No. 2001511/2020 (3rd Supplementary Record) U/s – 147 , 148 149, 302, 307, 323, 324, 341, 504 of IPC. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and seeing the serious nature of allegation to commit murder and cognizance order, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Rayazullah @ Md. Riyajullah @ Raju stands rejected . However the petitioner may surrender before the Ld. Trial Court and Ld. Trial Court will pass order keeping in consideration the totality of facts and without being prejudiced of this order.
