	02.06.2026	1. This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely, 1. Ramudgar Sharma and 2. Rahul Sharma, who are under custody since 25.04.2026, in connection with Narhaiya P.S Case No- 36/2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 329(4), 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Balram Kumar Jha, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel on behalf of the petitioners Sri Balram Kumar Jha has submitted that earlier no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioners either before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court and petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence and the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this false case due to land dispute and dirty party politics. It is also submitted that allegation against the petitioner is false and concocted and alleged all sections are bailable except U/s 109(1) & 303(2) of the BNS, which are ornamental and added only to make the offence non-bailable. Lastly, it is submitted that petitioners are under custody since 25.04.2026, Ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioners on bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in brief is that the informant of this case is Anita Devi. She has alleged that on 24.04.2026, due to previous enmity Ramudgar Sharma forcefully demolished the wall of her house, on protest Ramudgar Sharma started abusing her and all the accused persons named in FIR armed with lathi, kanti, dabiya etc, came and abused and assaulted her and Durga Nand Sharma	

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Contd... 02.06.2026	and Rahul Sharma molested her by tearing her blouse, when her daughter Priti Kumari and her mother-in-law came to rescue, accused also assaulted them and snatched golden chakti and mobile. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at length and perused the case record along with case diary and injury report available. From perusal of the record, it appears that on the basis of computer typed application given by the informant namely Anita Devi, before SHO Narhaiya P.S., this very case has been registered U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 329(4), 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the BNS against the petitioners and others. From perusal it also transpires that occurrence took place due to land dispute and as per allegation, accused petitioners and others abused and assaulted to the informant and her daughter namely Priti Kumari, who sustained injury and accused persons also molested the informant by tearing her blouse and snatched golden chakti and mobile. From perusal of the injury report, it transpires that injured Priti Kumari sustained injury, which is found simple in nature caused by hard blunt object. In spite of that from perusal of the para No. 30 of the case diary, no any criminal antecedent is found against the petitioners. Apart from that petitioners accused are under custody since 25.04.2026. 7. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts discussed above as well as clean antecedent of the petitioners and detention period, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners, namely, 1. Ramudgar Sharma and 2. Rahul Sharma on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each subject to condition as mentioned U/s 483 of the BNSS to the satisfaction of Ld. Court below with the following further conditions; I. That petitioners will co-operate in investigation and they make	
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Contd... 02.06.2026	themselves available whenever it is required by the investigating officer till submission of charge sheet if not chargesheeted yet. II. That the petitioners will attend the Court as per the bond conditions and petitioners will not commit the similar offence or offences in future. III. That the petitioners will not threaten, induce or promise any person acquainted with the facts of the case to prevent them from disclosing information. IV. An undertaking to follow the conditions as above be given on behalf of petitioners accused along with bail bond, in case of violation and breach of the conditions, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of their bail bond.
