This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused namely Puja Devi, who is under custody since 27.04.2026 in connection with Jhanjharpur P.S case No- 92/2021, U/s- 147, 341, 323, 307, 379, 354(B) of the IPC. 2. Heard Sri Sanjay Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Indrakant Prasad learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel Sri Sanjay Kumar on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that earlier no other bail petition has been filed on behalf of this petitioner before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It is further submitted that petitioner has two criminal antecedents and petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence. It is further submitted that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this false case due to family politics and prosecution case is totally false, concocted, baseless and no occurrence as alleged did ever took place. It is also submitted that there is a land dispute in between the parties and no case is made out U/s 307 of the IPC against the petitioner and petitioner is a parda nasin lady and other co-accused have already been enlarged on bail and the case of the petitioner stands on better footing. Lastly it is submitted that petitioner is in	

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	Contd. 20.05.2026	judicial custody since 27.04.2026. The learned counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in brief is that, the informant of this case is Pashupati Nath Sah, he has alleged that on 06.04.2021 at about 07:00 AM, all the accused persons named in FIR including this petitioner were forcefully surrounding and fencing his land, on protest all of them assaulted him by means of fist and slap and Shatrughan Sah assaulted over his head by means of tengari, resulted he got injured and accused Dhruv Sah snatched Rs. 600/-, when his family members came to rescue, accused persons also assaulted them and molested his wife. Hence this case. 6. Heard both sides at length and perused the case record along LCR including case diary and injury report. From perusal of the record, it transpires that, on the basis of written application submitted by informant victim namely Pashupati Nath Sah before SHO Jhanjharpur P.S., this very case has been registered U/s- 147, 341, 323, 307, 379, 354(B) of the IPC, against this petitioner and others. From perusal of the record, it also appears that as per allegation alleged in FIR, the main allegation of assault, is against co-accused Shatrughan Sah, who happens the husband of the

From perusal it also transpires that there is no any specific allegation of assault against the petitioner accused. Petitioner is a lady aged about 30 years. Apart from that from perusal of the injury report, it transpire that injuries are found simple in nature and petitioner is behind the bar since 27.04.2026 and other co-accused of the case have already granted bail in this case. 7. Therefore, considering aforesaid facts and circumstances, as well as detention period of the petitioner, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, namely, Puja Devi on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to conditions as mentioned U/s 483 of the BNSS to the satisfaction of Ld.
