Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Chandan Kumar Thakur, S/o- Dharm Dev Thakur aged-38 Years, R/o Village- Kariyahi, tole Ward No. 11, P.S.-Rajnagar, District-Madhubani in connection with Andharathadhi P.S. Case No. 111/ 2025 Gr.No.-1451/2025, U/s- 310(3),311 of BNS. 2. Heard Sri Rohit Anand , learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular bail petition has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has been further submitted that there is one criminal antecedent against the petitioner. It has further submitted that petitioner is in judicial custody since 27.02.2026. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on 23.07.2025 at about 12 in night 7 to 8 persons entered into the room of informants Rajesh Kumar where the wife of the informant and her daughter aged about 3 years was sleeping and assaulting with fists awoke the informant and demanded key of his house and on denying one person assaulted with rod on his head and another person assaulted with lathi some person took away valuable articles by breaking the boxes and VIP in which three lakhs cash and jewelry worth Rs. 15 Lakhs and took away gold, silver. The informant gave the information to the police from mobile on 112 and police reached at the house of informant and started searching. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that the name of this petitioner has surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused but nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and police have not produced any digital or electronic evidence regarding presence of accused at place of occurrence. On further perusal I find that no TIP has been conducted by the police and the petitioner is in custody since 27.02.2026. Further co-accused has been granted bail in BP	

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04.06.2026	No. 459/2025, BP No. 182/2026, BP No. 154/2026 and in Cri. Misc No. 75469/2025 dated 11.02.2025. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody, the petitioner Chandan Kumar Thakur is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, to the satisfaction of the learned trial court concerned and with further condition that the petitioner will not be involved in case of similar nature in future and will co-operate in investigation.
