Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Raja Mukhiya @ Raj Kumar Mukhiya @ Rajesh Mukhiya aged about 25 years S/o- Kameshwar Mukhiya, R/o-Village- Bhakhrain, PS.- Madhepur ,District Madhubani, in connection with Madhepur P.S Case No- 89/2026 Gr.No.-734/2026, U/s- 302(2),3(5) of BNS 2. Heard Sri Lakshmi Kant Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular bail petition has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further stated that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. It has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 08.04.2026. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on 06.04.2026 at 4 O'Clock when the informant Manish Kumar Jha had slept then his Mobile and money and mobile of other laborers were committed theft by unknown persons. 6. Perused the case record, case diary, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to commit theft of mobile and money. On further perusal I find that petitioner is in custody since 08.04.2026 and police have submitted charge sheet against the petitioner. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody, the petitioner Raja Mukhiya @ Raj Kumar Mukhiya @ Rajesh Mukhiya is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, with an undertaking under section	

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05.06.2026	437 (3) Cr.P.C, to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned and with further condition that the petitioner will not be involved in case of similar nature in future and will co-operate in investigation.
