This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely Ram Udgar Yadav, who is under custody since 01.05.2026, in connection with Ghoghardiha P.S Case No- 209/1998, U/s-447, 448, 323, 380, 427, 504, 34 of the IPC. 2. Heard Sri Kamlesh Kumar Yadav, Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioner and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. counsel of the petitioner Sri Kamlesh Kumar Yadav has submitted that earlier no other bail petition either before this Court of before Hon'ble High Court has been filed and petitioner has one criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence and petitioner was enjoying the privilege of notice U/s 41(1) of the Cr.Pc and cognizance has been taken against the petitioner U/s-452, 323, 504, 380, 427, 506, 34 of the IPC and after that this is the first appearance of accused and on 28.04.2024 NBW was issued against the petitioner. It is also submitted that co-accused has been enlarged on bail. Lastly, it is submitted that petitioner is under custody since 01.05.2026, Ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that the informant of this case is Khushi Lal Sahu, he has alleged that on 28.11.1998 at 07:00 AM all the accused persons named in FIR including this petitioner destroyed his house and	

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Contd... 10.06.2026		took his household articles and also threatened for dire consequences. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at length and perused the case record along with LCR including case diary. From perusal of the record it transpires that, on the basis of written application submitted by informant namely Khushi Lal Sahu, this very case has been registered U/s-447, 448, 323, 380, 427, 504, 34 of the IPC against the petitioner and other. From perusal of the record it also transpires that it is a case of year 1998 when and the petitioner not appeared before the concern Court, process U/s 83 of the CrPc. was issued against him and accordingly remanded in this case on dated 01.05.2026. Petitioner is a senior citizen aged about 62 yeas. From perusal of the FIR it also transpires that there is no any specific allegation against the petitioner accused. 7. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts as discussed above, as well as petitioner is still under custody since 01.05.2026 for more than one month, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, namely Ram Udgar Yadav, on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of Ld. Court below with following conditions; I. That petitioner will co-operate in trial and he make himself available whenever it is required by the Court. II. That the petitioner will attend the Court as per the bond conditions and petitioner will not commit the similar offence or
