Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Niranjan Kumar @ Niranjan Kamat, aged about 20 years, S/o- Sashi Bhusan Kamat, R/o Village -Kunauli, PS.-Kunauli , District Supaul, in connection with Phulparas RS P.S Case No- 61/2024 Gr.No.-244/2024,U/s- 494 of IPC & 27 of Arms Act 2. Heard Sri Kamlesh Kumar Yadav learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular bail petition has been filed earlier on behalf of the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has further been stated that petitioner has two criminal antecedent. It has further been stated that petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2026. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. 4. The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on 18.02.2024 at around 7:45 PM when informant's son Santosh Kumar Sah was going to his home from Andhrathari on motorcycle and reached near the bridge situated beside brick kiln of Santosh Singh, miscreants after hatching conspiracy were waiting there from before with the intention to kill and fired two round Bullets as a result of which informants son was badly injured. The miscreants left his son in injured condition there itself and took his motorcycle bearing reg No. BR07N-4305 and fled away. While fleeing away they were waving pistol. The informant admitted his injured son at Sub Divisional Hospital, Phulparas where from he was refereed to DMCH, Darbhanga for better treatment. 6. Perused the case record, case diary,LCR, submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record and found that there is allegation against the petitioner to commit robbery of motorcycle at the instance of firing and police have submitted charge sheet against the petitioner U/s- 394 of IPC and U/s-27 of Arms act. Further the petitioner has two criminal antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the serious nature of allegation against the petitioner, the above said bail petition filed on behalf of the accused Niranjan Kumar @ Niranjan Kamat stands rejected.
