	16.06.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused namely Hem Kant Kumar, seeking pre-arrest bail, in connection with Arariya Sangram P.S. Case No. 12/2025, U/s- 115(2), 126(2), 109, 3(5) of the BNS & 25(1-b) a 26/27/35 of Arms Act.. 2. Heard Sri Ravindra Kumar Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Indrakant Prasad learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel Sri Ravindra Kumar Singh on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that earlier no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner and petitioner has no any criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence and prosecution story is totally false, fabricated, concocted and vague and no occurrence has taken place as alleged in the FIR. It is further submitted that this false case has been filed by the informant due to dirty village party politics and the petitioner is not named in FIR while during supervision Police added the name of the petitioner and no case is made out against the petitioner under aforesaid sections. Lastly Ld. Counsel has submitted that there is no chance of his absconding if he be enlarged on bail and prayed to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail.	

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Contd. 16.06.2026	4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in brief is that the informant of this case Obedullah, who has stated in his fardbyan that on 26.02.2025 at about 19:20, he was taking tea at the shop of Md. Rahiman near Navin HP petrol pump and in the meantime 8-9 persons riding on motorcycle, stopped a bus and started quarreling and when Md. Badal, Pintu and other persons, who were sitting at that shop, stopped them to do so, then 5-6 persons returned back from there and reset 2-3 persons started quarreling with Badal and in the mean time one person called his friend and fired thrice, one bullet hit on his leg and one bullet hit on Md. Naim's hand. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at the length and perused the case record along with LCR including case diary and injury report available. From perusal of the record it transpires that on the basis of fardbyan made by informant Obedullah, this very case has been registered U/s- 115(2), 126(2), 109, 3(5) of the BNS & 25(1-b) a 26/27/35 of Arms Act., against unknown accused persons. Further it transpires that petitioner's name figured in para 50 of the case diary in confessional statement of co-accused Dipikaran Paswan in which he confessed that he along with this petitioner and other co-accused wanted to show the power, so he took one country made pistol and fired, due to which 2-3	
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Contd. 16.06.2026	co-villagers sustained injury. It also transpires that empty cartridge was also recovered from the spot. 7. Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances discussed above as well as serious nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail, accordingly prayer for anticipatory bail on behalf of petitioner namely Hem Kant Kumar, is hereby rejected.
