Rita Devi aged about 47 years W/o- Ganga Prasad Yadav 4. Soni Kumari aged about 20 years D/o- Ganga Prasad Yadav 5. Radha Kumari @ Radha Devi aged about 23 years W/o- Bablu Kumar Yadav 6. Heard Sri Rishi Kumar Jha for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioner is innocent, has not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. It has further submitted that petitioner no. 1,3,4 ,8 have one criminal antecedent filed by informant's husband remaining have no criminal antecedent. It was also submitted that the petitioner is local man and there is no chance of his absconding, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on 02.04.2026 at about 05:30 PM the informant was at his door and due to previous land dispute with a common intention all accused armed with Lathi, Kudal & iron rod assaulted informant and his family members. 6. Perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, case	

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cont. 10.06.2026	diary and submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record, I find that there is allegation against the petitioner to assault informant and his family members. On further perusal I find that there is land dispute between the parties and there is case and counter case between the parties. Further as per para 33 the nature of injury is simple. 7. In the facts and circumstances mentioned above, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. Bablu Kumar Yadav @ Bablu Yadav 2. Prabhas Kumar Yadav @ Prabhas Yadav 3. Rita Devi 4. Soni Kumari 5. Radha Kumari @ Radha Devi 6. Manjula Devi 7. Vikas Kumar Yadav @ Vikas Kumar and 8. Ganga Prasad Yadav is hereby disposed with direction to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within fifteen days and Ld. Trial Court will pass order keeping in consideration the totallity of facts and without being prejudiced of this order.
