	07.07.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused namely 1. Manish Sah @ Manish Kumar & 2. Heera Lal Sah @ Heera Lal Kumar, seeking pre-arrest bail, in connection with Ghoghardiha P.S case No- 74/2025, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 329(4), 110, 303 (2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Rajeev Kumar Jha Ld. Advocate on behalf of petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad, learned APP for the state. 3. Ld. Counsel Sri Rajeev Kumar Jha on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that earlier on behalf of these petitioners no other bail petition has been filed before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court Patna and petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence and alleged all sections are bailable except U/s 110 & 118(1) of the BNS, which are not made out against these petitioners and informant and petitioners are of the same family members. It is also submitted that there is delay of 9 days in lodging the FIR and there is case and counter case and land dispute in between the parties. Lastly it is submitted that petitioners have apprehending their arrest in this case, ld. Counsel prays to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. 4. The learned APP Sri Indrakant Prasad opposed the prayer of bail and

The prosecution story in brief is that, informant of this case is Ajab Lal Sah and he has stated in his fardbyan that on 03.05.2025 at about 03:00 PM, he was sitting at his doorstep and asked his daughter-in-law namely Manju Devi that some one has broken the mango plant, then all the accused persons named in FIR, including these petitioners, armed with lathi, tengari, farsa, knife, iron rod, surrounded him and his son namely Jay Narayan Sah assaulted him by means of tengari over his head, resulted he got head injury. Further the informant alleged that his daughter-in-law Mamta Devi assaulted him by means of iron rod, due to which he fell down, when his daughter-in-law Manju Devi came to save him, accused Hira Lal Sah and Manish Sah assaulted her by means of lathi, iron rod and she fell down, Poonam Devi snatched mangalsutra from her and Swarup Sah snatched Rs. 13000/- from the pocket of the informant and on information Dial 112 Police Team took injured to Ghoghardiha Hospital for treatment. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at length and perused the case record along with LCR including case diary and injury report. From perusal of the record it transpires that on the basis of fardbyan made by the informant namely Ajab Lal Sah, this very case has been registered U/s-126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 329(4), 110, 303 (2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS. against these petitioners and others and from perusal it also appears that petitioners accused are named in the FIR and as per allegation, there is specific allegation against	
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Contd. 07.07.2026	the petitioners to assault the informant and his daughter-in-law namely Manju Devi by means of lathi and iron rod, resulted the victim informant sustained multiple sharp cut injuries on mild of scalp measuring 1½" x ¼" x ¼" and 1" x ¼" x ¼" and NCCT of brain of Ajab Lal Sah shows few small infarcts in bilateral fronto-parietal white matter and generalized brain atrophy and as per opinion of the Doctor mentioned in injury report, that several attempts on head region as by assaultation and it is dangerous to life because of severe bleeding. Despite that his daughter-in-law Manju Devi also sustained injury bleeding with nose. From perusal it also transpires that earlier the anticipatory bail of co-accused persons has already been rejected by this court vide ABP No. 738/2025. 7. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and discussions made above as well as specific allegation against these petitioners, I am not inclined to enlarge these petitioners on anticipatory bail accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail on behalf of petitioners namely 1.
