	11.06.2026	- Regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused in custody namely Rupesh Kumar Yadav, aged about 20 years S/o- Dilip Yadav, resident of Vill.- Bakua, Bhargama, P.S- Bheja, Dist- Madhubani in connction with Madhepur P.S case No- -150/2025 Gr.No.-1714/2025, U/s- 308(2),308(3) of BNS & 3(27) of Arms Act. - Heard Sri Ramesh Chandra Thakur, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha learned APP for the state. - The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner filed an Anticipatory Bail vide A.B.P No. 759/2025 before your Honor which has been rejected by the DASJ III on 15.12.2025 and subsequently filed ABP before the Hon'ble Patna High Court vide Crim. Misc. No. 9016/26 which was withdrawn. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It has been further stated that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He has further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 04.04.2026. It has further been submitted that there is no recovery of any article or gun from the possession of petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner is a local man and he is ready to furnish the satisfactory bailors, if he be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prays to allow the petition. - The learned APP opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject it. - The prosecution case in short is that on 03.09.2025 a secret information was received by police that petitioner extorted money from the different shopkeepers by showing his photographs with arms. - Perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, case diary and submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record, I find that there is allegation against the petitioner to extort money from the different shopkeepers by showing his photographs with arms. On further perusal I find that petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2026 and police have submitted charge sheet against this petitioner.

In the facts and circumstances mentioned above and keeping in view the period of custody, the petitioner namely Rupesh Kumar Yadav is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10000/- with two sureties of like amount, with an undertaking under section 437 (3) of Cr.P.C, to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned and with further condition that the petitioner will not be involved in case of similar nature in future and will co-operate in trial. <u>Further the petitioner will file bail bond after framing of charge.</u> Dictated and corrected by Anil Kumar Ram District & Additional Sessions Judge III Jhanjharpur	
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
