	23.06.2026	1. This is the anticipatory bail application U/s – 482 of BNSS seeking pre-arrest bail by the accused persons namely 1. Krishna Mohan Sah aged about 27 years S/o- Santosh Sah 2. Dhyani Sahu aged about 76 years S/o- Late Anuthi Sahu Both R/o Vill-Madhepur, P.S.- Madhepur, District- Madhubani in connection with Madhepur P.S case No- 144/2026 Gr.No.-1141/2026 U/s-126(2),115(2),117(2),109(1),351(2),352(2),3(5) of BNS. 2. Heard Sri Ranjeeta Kumari for the petitioner and Sri Deo Shankar Jha, learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that no any sort of bail petition has earlier been filed in this court or any higher court. It was further submitted that the petitioners are innocent, have not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case. It has further submitted that petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It was also submitted that the petitioners are local man and there is no chance of their absconding, if they be enlarged on bail. The learned counsel prayed to allow the petitioner on bail. 4. The learned APP opposed the petition and prayed to reject it. 5. The prosecution case in short is that on 20.05.2026 the accused assaulted with stick to the informant on the issue of saying not to encroach and construct in the public way. Further the informant was treated at PHC Madhepur and was referred at DMCH for better treatment. 6. Perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, case diary and submissions of both the parties and other materials available on record, I find that there is allegation against the petitioner to assault the informant with stick on head and the petitioner was treated firstly at PHC Madhepur and later he was referred at DMCH Laheriasaria for better treatment. The witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para 7,8,9 of the case diary and investigation is going on. The nature of injury is reserved.
