	07.07.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition, filed on behalf of petitioner namely 1. Kartik Bhindwar, 2. Birendra @ Veeran Yadav, 3. Lalbabu Kumar @ Lalbabu Bhindwar, 4. Brahm Bhindwar @ Brahmdeo Bhindwar, seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Laukaha P.S case No- 76/2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 324(4), 329(3), 329(4), 76, 109(1), 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the BNS. 2. Heard Sri Baleshwar Gurmaita, Ld. Advocate on behalf of aforesaid petitioners and Sri Indrakant Prasad learned APP for the state. 3. The learned counsel Sri Baleshwar Gurmaita on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that earlier no other bail petition has been filed on behalf of these petitioners either before Sessions Court or before Hon'ble High Court Patna and petitioners have no criminal antecedent and are quite innocent, have committed no offence as alleged in the FIR. It is further submitted that prosecution story is totally false and concocted and no case is made out U/s 109(1), 303(2) & 76 of the BNS against the petitioners and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to malice, grudge and dirty village party politics. It is also submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners and there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Lastly it is submitted that case has been compromised in between the parties and petitioners have apprehending their arrest, ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail.

The prosecution case in short is that, the informant of this case is Siya Ram Chaudhary, he has alleged that on 01.04.2026 at 07:00 PM, all the accused persons named in FIR including these petitioners came and started abusing him, on protest all the accused persons started assaulting him by means of lathi, danda and iron rod, resulted he got injury below left ear, when his family members came to rescue, all the accused persons assaulted them and some of the accused persons also molested his wife. Hence, this case. 6. Heard both sides at the length and perused the case record along with case diary including injury report available. From perusal of the record it transpires that, on the basis of written application submitted before SHO Laukaha P.S. by informant victim Siya Ram Chaudhary, this very case has been registered U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2), 324(4), 329(3), 329(4), 76, 109(1), 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the BNS, against these petitioners and other accused person. From perusal of the record it transpires that as per allegation alleged in the FIR it is alleged that on the date and time of the occurrence, accused petitioners forming an unlawful assembly having deadly weapons in their hands such as lathi, danda etc, came and assaulted to the informant by means of iron rod, resulted informant sustained injury. From perusal of the injury report no any visible injury has been found rather pain and tenderness is found. From perusal it also transpires that informant and injured persons
