The present Anticipatory Bail Application has been preferred by Petitioner namely **Md. Adil Alam** s/o Khurshid Alam who is apprehension of arrest in connection with Dharahara P.S. Case No. 17 of 2026 under Sections 64, 308 & 352 of BNS, pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-III, Munger. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner is present on calling and Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State is also present.

As per the Bail Application, it is submitted that the Petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence and falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that there is no incident happened as stated by Informant and the Petitioner has not made any illicit video. The Informant lended money with the Petitioner in 2023 and on asking for return his money then the Informant has not returned his money and registered a false case against him and there is 14 days delay in filing of FIR against the Petitioner and there is no explanation and the Informant has falsely implicated the Petitioner in this case. In para-2 of the Application, it is certified that the Petitioner has not previously filed any Bail Application before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court of Patna. The Petitioner have no criminal antecedent. The Petitioner is ready to furnish the bail bond and he is also ready to comply with direction of this Court. Hence, it is prayed to enlarge the Petitioner on Anticipatory Bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the present Bail Application

As per the written statement of the prosecution story is that the Informant-cum-Victim namely Mamta Devi alleged that In September 2023, Mohammad Adil Alam used to visit the informant's house for collection of group

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installments. On one occasion, when the informant was alone and changing clothes, her photograph was secretly taken. That photograph was shown to the informant and she was threatened that it would be circulated if she did not agree to have physical relations. Out of fear, sexual intercourse was forcibly committed with her, and a video was also secretly recorded. Thereafter, the informant was repeatedly threatened, harassed, and money was demanded from her. When she refused to have relations or pay money, she was abused at her house. A village panchayat was held, but no change was made in his conduct, and harassment continued for several months. Due to shame and fear, no case was filed earlier. On 20.01.2026, when the informant was alone at her house, the accused entered the house and again tried to force physical relations. On her raising alarm, villagers came there, whereupon the accused fled from the place and was seen running away. It is, therefore, prayed that a case be registered and legal action be taken against the accused.

Heard both sides and perused the records.

From the perusal of the case record, it is clear that the Petitioner is sole accused person in FIR and there is direct allegation against him that he secretly took the informant's photograph while she was changing clothes, threatened to make the photograph public and on that basis forcibly established physical relations with her and recorded a video. Thereafter, he continued to threaten and harass her and demanded money. All prosecution witnesses in paras- 2 & 6 of the case diary have supported the case of prosecution. Para-26 of the case diary contained the statement of victim under Section 183 of BNSS in which she has fully supported the case of prosecution. This case is still under investigation.

Therefore, considering aforesaid facts and circumstances of the

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case as discussed above, nature of the allegation, present status of this case, statements of victim under Section 183 of BNSS, I am of the view that there is direct allegation against the Petitioner to take the informant's photograph while she was changing clothes, threatened to make the photograph public, and on that basis forcibly established physical relations with her and recorded a video. Thereafter, he continued to threaten and harass her and demanded money which is serious in nature and the Petitioner is sole accused person in this case. Hence, the Petitioner does not deserve the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer of bail of the Petitioner namely Md. Adil Alam is hereby Rejected.
