Abhishek Roy @ Govinda Vs. The State of Bihar

Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 221/2025

1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioner **Abhishek Roy @ Govinda** S/o- Vijay Prasad Tanti who is lying in judicial custody since 14.12.2025 in connection with Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 221/2025 u/s 309(6) of B.N.S., pending in the Court of Ld. C.J.M., Munger.

2. The informant has alleged that on 08.12.2025 at about 01:00 A.M. three unknown persons have physically assaulted him on gun point and snatched away cash amount of Rs. 1200/- and a mobile phone from him near Daulatpur Middle School while he was going towards Jamalpur Railway Station. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

3. At the outset the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has certified that previously no regular or anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioner has two criminal cases pending against him.** He further submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and further that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. That the petitioner is not a named accused of the F.I.R. rather his name came up in the case in the confessional statement of co-accused Shankar Tanti. That nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. That the present petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 14.12.2025. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the present petitioner be enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. PP has opposed the bail application of the petitioner and submits that the petitioner is not a named accused of the F.I.R. rather his name came up in the case in the confessional statement of co-accused Shankar Tanti.

5. Heard the submissions of respective Ld. Counsels and perused

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the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the case record, it appears that the charge in the case has already been framed. From the injury report, it is apparent that the injuries are simple in nature. That the present petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 14.12.2025.

7. Hence, considering the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and the circumstances, this bail application is hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court **with conditions that one of the bailors shall be family member of the petitioner and that the petitioner shall file an undertaking that he will not tamper with any of the evidences or influence any of the witnesses of the case and that he shall remain physically present before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every date.**
