The present Anticipatory Bail Application has been preferred by Petitioners namely **(1) Rajbeer Manjhi** s/o Shashi Bhushan Manjhi and **(2) Laddu Manjhi** s/o Mahendra Manjhi who are apprehending of arrest in connection with Kharagpur P.S. Case No. 271 of 2025 under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 109, 303(2), 191(2) & 190 of BNS pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-I, Munger. Learned Counsel for the Petitioners' is present on calling and Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State is also present.

As per the Bail Application, it is submitted that the Petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence and falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the Petitioners are simple labours. The actually on 12.12.2025 the husband of the Informant and his brother after taking wine entered into the house of these Petitioners and brutally assaulted the accused persons and others, for that Kharagpur P.S. Case No. 270 of 2025 was registered at the instance of co-accused namely Babita Devi. For saving the skin from that the present case was registered against the Petitioners. The co-accused persons granted bail earlier by this Court vide ABA No. 32 of 2026 on 20.02.2026. In para-2 of the Application, it is certified that the Petitioners have previously filed an Anticipatory Bail Application which was withdrawn by the Petitioners vide ABA No. 32 of 2026 on 28.01.2026 and no any other Bail Application filed before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court of Patna. The Petitioner No. 2 have one criminal antecedent and Petitioner No. 1 have two criminal antecedents. The Petitioners are ready to furnish the bail bond and they are also ready to comply with direction of this Court. Hence, it is prayed to enlarge the Petitioners on Anticipatory Bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the present Bail Application

As per the written statement of the prosecution story is that the Informant namely Shalu Devi alleged that Shashi Bhushan Manjhi, Bibita Devi, Rabindra Manjhi, Reva Devi, Rajbeer Manjhi and Laddu Manjhi assaulted with an axe on the head of husband of Informant. She further alleged that Rabindra Manjhi and Rajbeer Manjhi assaulted with iron rod the Informant. She further alleged that Rekha Devi and Babita Devi snatched Rs. 2,000/- (Two Thousand Rupees) on the pocket of Informant's husband. The injured persons went Kharagpur Primary Health Centre for treatment and referred to Sadar Hospital, Munger. She further alleged that the accused persons threatened to file a false case under SC/ST Act.

Heard both sides and perused the records.

On perusal of the case records, it appears that the petitioners are named in FIR along with others and there is allegation against the Petitioners to assault the Informant with axe and iron rod which resulted in to several injuries. All prosecution witness in paras-6, 7, 8, 9 & 88 of the case diary have supported the case of prosecution. Para-31 of the case diary contained two criminal antecedents against the Petitioner No. 1 and One criminal antecedent of Petitioner No.3. As per injury report of Navneet Kumar in which doctor has opined the injury is grievous in nature which is caused by hard and blunt substance. There is case and counter case between both sides and this case is still under investigation.

Therefore, considering aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as discussed above, nature of the allegation, present status of this case, criminal antecedent as per para-3 of the bail application as well as case diary, nature of injuries, granting of bail earlier of co-accused persons by this Court as

well as case and counter case between both sides. I am of the view that there omnibus allegation against the Petitioners and there is case and counter between both sides. Hence, the Petitioners deserve the privilege of Anticipatory Bail.

Accordingly, the prayer of bail of the Petitioners namely **(1) Rajbeer Manjhi** and **(2) Laddu Manjhi** stands **Allowed** with conditons on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000x2/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court concerned with condition that;

1. One bailor will be close relative of the Petitioners who undertakes how they are related with the Petitioners.
2. The Petitioners undertake not to threat the prosecution witnesses after their release and co-operate the police during investigation.
3. Surrender within Twenty (20) days from the receipt of the order to Court below.
