ANTICIPATORY BAIL APPLICATION No.- 248/2026

Randhir Yadav and others. Vs. The State of Bihar

1. A petition dated 20.02.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner No. 1 namely Randhir Yadav seeking permission to withdraw his anticipatory bail application, in connection with Shampur P.S. Case No. 137/2025.
2. The Ld. Counsel submits due to mistake of facts the petitioner wants to withdraw his anticipatory bail application, hence he may be permitted to withdraw the same.
3. The Ld. P.P. raised no objection.
4. Heard. Perused the petition dated 20.02.2026
5. Prayer is **Allowed**. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application with respect to Petitioner No. 1 namely Randhir Yadav is **Dismissed as Withdrawn** as prayed for.
6. Put up for hearing for the rest petitioner.

1. The present anticipatory bail application has been preferred by petitioners **2. Nikhil Yadav, S/o- Randhir Yadav and 3. Pancham Yadav, S/o- Anuplal Yadav** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Shampur P.S. Case No. 137/2025 u/ss 115(2), 126(2), 109(1), 308(4), 303(2), 352 and 3(5) of B.N.S., pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M. Ist, Munger.

2. The informant has alleged that all the accused persons including the petitioners abused and assaulted him and his family members with butt of pistol and demanded extortion of Rs. 50,000 . He further alleged that co-accused Pancham Yadav snatched away gold chain from his mother. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

3. At the outset the Ld. Counsel certified that previously no anticipatory or regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioners have no criminal antecedents**. That the Ld. Counsel submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence and further that they have been falsely implicated in the present case. That there are land disputes between the parties and they have preferred case and counter case against each other. That no case u/ss 109(1) of B.N.S.S. is made out against the petitioners. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the petitioners be granted the privilege of pre-arrest bail.

4. The Ld. P.P. has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of

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the petitioners.

5. Heard the submissions of respective Id. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the record it seems that the specific allegations qua the petitioners are that they physically assaulted one Nandan Kumar and Suman Kumar and from their respective injury reports it is apparent that Suman Kumar have suffered simple injuries and the NCCT of brain of Nandan Kumar shows 'no significant abnormality' whereas from the respective injury reports of the rest victims it is apparent that the injuries are simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. That there are land disputes between the parties for which they have preferred case and counter case against each other.

8. However, considering the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail application for the petitioner No. 2 and 3 namely **Nikhil Yadav and Pancham Yadav** are hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within 15 days from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court subject to the conditions as laid down U/S 482(2) B.N.S.S.
