Application for restoration of the complaint

Present: Sh. Arvinder Singh Walia, Advocate for the applicant/complainant.

Heard on the application to revive the above titled complaint which was disposed of vide order dated 11.05.2024 with the order if accused will not pay the remaining amount of Rs.2,50,000/- in installment of Rs.10,000/- after every two month from first installment, then case will be revived. It is averred in the application that the above titled complaint has been taken up in National Lok Adalat on 11.05.2024, wherein Ms. Kanu complainant suffered statement to the effect that compromise has been effected between the parties for Rs.3,00,000/- as full and final settlement. Out of which, it was settled in National Lok Adalat that accused had paid Rs.50,000/- on 16.04.2024 and remaining amount of Rs.2,50,000/- in installments of Rs.10,000/- after every two months from first installments in the bank will be paid. It was also written in the said order that if, accused failed to pay the total compromise amount within stipulated period, she shall be liable to revived the complaint. That as per settlement, the accused has not deposited/paid amount of Rs.2,50,000/-. Therefore, the complainant wants to pursue the above titled case. It is prayed that application be allowed, in the interest of justice.

2. I have heard learned counsel representing the applicant/complainant and have also gone through the case file. Original file received and perused. Perusal of the record reveals that Complaint No. NACT-56-2021 was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 11.05.2024 passed by the learned predecessor of this Court. Said order has been reproduced as under:

“File taken up before the National Lok Adalat. Complainant Kanu has already suffered statement on 06.02.2024 that matter has been compromised with the accused.

.....In amicable settlement complainant compromised the matter with the accused and as per the compromise accused had paid Rs.50,000/- on 16.04.2024 and remaining amount of Rs.2,50,000/- in installments of Rs.10,000/- after every two months from first installment. Accused will deposit the amount in complainant's Bank account No.81702200049230 of Canara Bank, Branch Railway Road, Nangal. Statement of Chandni, Accused has recorded her statement to this effect and further statement of Sh. Kanu, complainant is also recorded. Accordingly, an award is hereby passed in terms and conditions that a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- shall be paid by the defendant to plaintiff as full and final payment as per her statement. Both the parties shall remain bound by their statements and in event of failure of accused to pay the amount as settled, the complainant shall be at liberty to proceed as per law against accused and can revive the complainant from the present stage. Papers be consigned to Judicial Record Room, after due compliance as per rules.

3. As per the order dated 11.05.2024 it was directed that the parties shall remain bound by their statement and it was also mentioned that

in case accused failed to pay the amount as settled complainant can revive its complaint from the stage of the case. Since the accused has failed to comply with the terms of order dated 11.05.2024 and has not made the payment to the applicant/complainant as per compromise, accordingly, present application for restoration is allowed and the complaint is ordered to be restored to its original number. Ahlmad is directed to register the complaint at its original number. File of the restoration application be tied at with the main file and copy of this order be also placed on the main file.

4. Now to come up on **17.07.2026** for arguments on application under Section 143-A of NI Act and also to come to procure the presence of accused, she be summoned through non bailable warrants for the date fixed.
