Pramod Kumar Sah Vs. The State of Bihar
East Colony P.S. Case No. 19/2026

1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioner **Pramod Kumar Sah** S/o- Late Anandi Prasad who is lying in judicial custody since 03.04.2026 in connection with East Colony P.S. Case No. 19/2026 u/ss 223, 319(2) and 318(4) of B.N.S. and section 7 of Lottery Regulation Act, 1998, pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-II, Munger.

2. The informant who is a police officer has alleged that on information he along with the police team reached near the Railway Cinema Hall and apprehended the petitioner. On search, several lottery tickets and cash amount of Rs. 1540/- have been recovered from him. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

3. At the outset the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has certified that previously no regular or anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioner has no criminal history**. He further submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and further that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. That the police has not granted the benefit of section 35(3) of B.N.S.S. to the petitioner. That the petitioner's mother is suffering from cancer and he is the only care taker and in support of his contention he has filed an affidavit which is placed on record. That the present petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 03.04.2026. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the present petitioner be enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. PP has opposed the bail application of the petitioner.

5. Heard the submissions of respective Ld. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the case record, it appears that the petitioner's

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mother is suffering from cancer and in support of his contention he has filed an affidavit which is placed on record. That the petitioner has no criminal cases pending against him as per para 30 and 31 of the case diary. That the present petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 03.04.2026.

7. Hence, considering the nature of allegations, in the totality of the facts and the circumstances and on humanitarian ground, this bail application is hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court **with conditions that one of the bailors shall be family member of the petitioner and that the petitioner shall file an undertaking that he will not tamper with any of the evidences or influence any of the witnesses of the case and that he shall remain physically present before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every date.**
