1. Case called out.
2. The Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that an anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner was allowed vide order dated 26.11.2025 passed in A.B.A. No. 1410/2025 by this Court with direction to surrender before the learned Trial Court within 15 days of the order. He further submits that due to some unavoidable reason he could not appear before the Ld. Trial Court within the stipulated period. Therefore, it is prayed to extend the period of surrender before the learned Trial Court.
3. The Learned P.P. raised no objection.
4. Heard both the sides. Perused the case record and order dated 26.11.2025 passed in A.B.A. No. 1410/2025.
5. Considering the submissions of the ld. Counsel for the petitioners, the prayer is **Allowed**. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Trial Court within 10 (Ten) working days from the receipt / production of this order and the other conditions laid down in order dated 26.11.2025 passed in A.B.A. No. 1410/2025 shall remain intact.
6. The office is directed to send a copy of this order to the concern Court immediately.
