The present Anticipatory Bail Application has been preferred by Petitioner namely **Vishekha Devi** w/o Suman Mandal who is apprehension of arrest in connection with Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 52 of 2026 under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 74, 352, 351(2) & 3(5) of BNS pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-II, Munger. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner is present on calling and Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State is also present.

As per the Bail Application, it is submitted that the Petitioner is innocent and she has not committed any offence and falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the facts alleged in FIR, no case is made out under Section 109(1) & 74 of BNS against the Petitioner and the Petitioner never involved in this case either directly or indirectly and the Petitioner is own brother of of the Informant as well as there is property dispute between both sides. There is delay in lodging the FIR and no explanation in FIR for such abnormal delay. In para-2 of the Application, it is certified that the Petitioner has not previously filed any Bail Application before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court of Patna. The Petitioner have no criminal antecedent. The Petitioner is ready to furnish the bail bond and she is also ready to comply with direction of this Court. Hence, it is prayed to enlarge the Petitioner on Anticipatory Bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State vehemently opposed the present Bail Application.

As per the written statement of the prosecution story is that it

was alleged by the informant, Avdhesh Kumar that there is started quarrel between Informant and accused Baadshah @ Suman Mandal and started to abuse and assaulted with fists which resulted into he became unconscious. After sometime, the Informant saw accused Vishakha Devi dragged his wife with her hair and assaulted Baadshah @ Suman Mandal with iron rod which resulted into she also became unconscious and Vishakha Devi also assaulted Informant's wife with wooden stool. The Injured person went at Primary Health Centre, Bariyarpur for treatment but referred to Sadar Hospital Munger, thereafter again refer to JLN Medical Collage and Hospital, Bhagalpur for better treatment.

Heard both sides and perused the records.

From the perusal of the case record, it is clear that the Petitioner is named in FIR along with other and there is allegation against her to assault with rod and fists with the help of her husband and used abusive words with the Informant and her husband. All prosecution witnesses in paras-2, 3, 4 & 9 of the case diary have supported the case of prosecution. Para-34 of the case diary contained the injury report of injured person in which doctor has opined the injury is simple in nature, caused by hard and blunt substance. The co-accused person granted bail by this Court. This case is still under investigation. The allegation against her to abuse and assault the Informant and other and also dragged hair of Informant's wife.

Therefore, considering aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as discussed above, nature of the allegation, present status of this case, nature of injury, no criminal antecedent as per bail application and

case diary, granting of bail of co-accused person by this Court, close relation between both sides as well as petitioner being woman, I am of the view that there is allegation against the Petitioner to assault with rod and fists with the help of her husband and used abusive words with the Informant and her husband and the injury is simple nature. Hence, the Petitioner deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer of bail of the Petitioner namely **Vishekha Devi is hereby Allowed** with conditions on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000x2/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court concerned with condition that;

1. One bailor will be close relative of the Petitioner who undertakes how he/she is related with the Petitioner.
2. The Petitioner undertakes not to threat the prosecution witnesses his their release and co-operate the police during investigation.
3. Surrender within twenty (20) days from the receipt of order to Court below.
