1. The present anticipatory bail applications have been preferred by petitioners **1. Rita Devi**, W/o- Upendra Ram, **2. Upendra Ram**, S/o- Late Bakhodi Ram, **3. Sapna Kumari @ Sapna Devi**, D/0- Upendra Ram, **4. Nandani Devi Prasad @ Nandani Devi**, W/o- Rajesh Prasad and **5. Suman Devi**, W/o- Suraj Ram in **A.B.A No. 556/2026** as well as petitioner **Suraj Ram**, S/o- Upendra Ram in **A.B.A No. 583/2026**, in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 05/2026 U/Ss 85, 126(2), 115(2) and 3(5) of B.N.S. and section 3/4 of D.P. Act, pending in the Court of Ld. S.D.J.M., Munger.

2. As both these anticipatory bail applications arises out of same P.S., hence both were taken up for hearing together and are being disposed off by this common order.

3. The informant has alleged that her marriage with the petitioner Suraj Ram was solemnized on 29.03.2024 thereafter she went to her matrimonial house where she was subjected to torture and cruelty by all the accused persons including the petitioners towards dowry demand of a vehicle. She further alleged that her husband was going to solemnize another marriage on 21.04.2026. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

4. At the outset the Id. Counsels in both the anticipatory bail applications have certified that previously no any other anticipatory or regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioners have no criminal cases pending against them**. The Ld Counsel in both the anticipatory bail applications submitted that the petitioners are innocent and has not committed any offence and further that they have been falsely implicated in this case. That the

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petitioner of A.B.A No. 583/2026 is the husband and petitioners of A.B.A No. 556/2026 are the in-laws of the informant. That the police has already granted the benefit of section 35(3) of B.N.S.S. to the petitioners. That there are no specific allegations against the petitioners. Therefore the ld. Counsels in both the anticipatory bail applications plead that the petitioners be granted the privilege of pre-arrest bail.

5. The Ld. P.P has opposed the anticipatory bail applications of the petitioners.

6. Heard the submissions of respective ld. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

7. From perusal of case record, it appears that there are matrimonial disputes between the parties. That the police has already granted the benefit u/s 35(3) of B.N.S. to the petitioners. That the petitioners have no criminal cases pending against them as per para 3 of the present anticipatory bail applications.

8. Hence, considering the totality of the facts and the circumstances of the case, both the anticipatory bail applications are hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within 15 days from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court subject to the conditions as laid down U/S 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
