State Vs. Imteyaz

29.06.21 A bail petition filed on behalf of the accused namely Md.Imteyaz who is in custody since 30.09.2020 in connection with Kotwali P.S Case No. 208 of 2014 under sections 25(1-B)A, 26(i)(ii) of the Arms Act is put up for hearing today on virtual mode.

Heard Sri Rakesh Kumar, learned lawyer for the defence as well as learned Addl.P.P Sri Piyush Kumar.

It is submitted on behalf of the learned Defence counsel that petitioner is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. No other bail application has been filed on behalf of this petitioner either this court or any Superior Court, Patna. Petitioner is a poor laborer and he went out of State for his bread and he instructed his Karpardaz to do proper Pairbi but the Karpardaz of this case did not filed proper Pairbi in this reason the petitioner's bail bond has been can-celled on 22.12.2015. the petitioner has remanded in this case on 30.09.20. therefore, it is prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Per contra learned Addl.P.P opposed the bail prayer of this petitioner.

On perusal of the case record, it reveals that petitioner is in custody since 30.09.20. Hence, it proper to **allow** his bail prayer on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each with condition that he shall present each and every date otherwise learned Addl.P.P is at liberty to give petition for cancellation of his bail bonds.
