ANTICIPATORY BAIL APPLICATION No.-576/ 2026

Rupesh Kumar Vs. The State of Bihar
Kasimbazar P.S. Case No.- 261/2025

1. The present anticipatory bail application has been preferred by petitioner **(1)** Rupesh Kumar who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kasimbazar P.S. Case No.- 261/2025 u/s- 126(2)/115(2)/127(2)/109/303(2)/61(2)/3(5) of BNS and 27 Arms Act, pending in the Court of Ld. C.J.M., Munger,

2. As per FIR prosecution story in brief is that on dated- 05.09.2025 at about 3:00 PM informant had parked his Bolero vehicle near Sultangan Railway Station. Two boys came and requested for booking. Informant agreed to take them on fare for Rs.1500. At around 04:00 PM when he reached near Shastri Nagar in munger one boy got off near police line. The other boy who ha hired the vehicle took him to a house and had parked his vehicle insie the boundary of the house, and went inside. Meanwhile, another boy came from inside the house and locked the gate. Informant got scared and tried to run towards the gate, but those people, with intent to kill him, opened fire at the street and caught him. All of them together started beating him with fists, punches, and sticks, and put weapons to his body and said, “if you try to run, we will shoot you.” Accused persons took out his PAN Card, Aahaar Card, and Driving License from pocket. The boy who was guarding him opened the gate at 11:00 PM and took him on a motorcycle, left him on

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the road and fled. Then he caught a Toto and reached Jamalpur Station and informed the police.

Hence the information, based on which the above stated Kasimbazar P.S. Case No.- 261/2025 was registered u/s-126(2)/115(2)/127(2)/109/303(2)/61(2)/3(5) of BNS and 27 Arms Act.

3. At the outset the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has certified that previously no anticipatory or regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioner has one criminal history**. Further, it is submitted that petitioners have no hand in alleged occurrence and there is no specific allegation against them. The Ld. Counsel submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and further that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that other co-accused has been granted bail from this Court in this case.

Therefore, the Ld. Counsel pleads that the petitioner be granted the privilege of pre-arrest bail.

4. The Ld. A.P.P. has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

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5. Heard the submissions of respective Id. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. Perused the case record. As per para-3 of the case diary it transpire that name of this petitioner appeared in confessional statement of other accused in Kasimbazar P.S. case no-260/2025 and found true. T.I.P has not been conducted. Petitioner is having one criminal antecedent. Investigation is going on in this case. In this situation, this Court is not inclined to grant bail. Accordingly, considering the nature of allegations this bail petition is **dispose off**.
Petitioner may file ABA after submission of charge-sheet.
