1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioner **Abhishek Kumar @ Manish Kumar** S/o- Kuldeep Yadav, who is lying in judicial custody since **28.12.2025** in connection with **Naya Ram Nagar P.S. Case No. 126 of 2025** registered U/S 126(2), 115(2), 191(2), 193(3), 190, 263, 117(2), 109, 121(1), 132, 352, 351(2), 351(3) of B.N.S. pending in the Court of Sri Pradip Kumar, Ld. J.M. -Ist class, Munger.

2. That the informant, who is a police officer, has alleged that on information he along with his team raided at the spot where he found that the petitioner along with other co-accused persons were involved in making of illegal wine. That he further alleged that they arrested three accused persons including the petitioner from the spot but they succeeded in fleeing away with the help of other co-accused persons. Further he alleged that the petitioner Abhishek Kumar and Monu Raj physically assaulted him as a result of which he suffered injuries. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. Case No. was registered.

3. At the outset, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has certified that previously no other regular or anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Court or before any other court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. That the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further deposed that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. That the Ld. Trial Court has already taken cognizance in the case. That some of the co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 02.04.2026 in B.A No. 686/2026 and B.A No. 700/2026. That the petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 28.12.2025. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the present petitioner be

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enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. PP has opposed the bail application of the petitioner.

5. Heard the submissions of respective Id. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of case record, it appears that the cognizance in the case has already been taken by the Ld. Trial Court. From the injury report, it is apparent that the injuries are simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. That some of the co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 02.04.2026 in B.A No. 686/2026 and B.A No. 700/2026. That the petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 28.12.2025.

7. Hence, considering the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and the circumstances, this bail application is hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court **with conditions that one of the bailors shall be family member of the petitioner and that the petitioner shall file an undertaking that he will not tamper with any of the evidences or influence any of the witnesses of the case and that he shall remain physically present before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every date.**
