<u>01.06.2026</u>	Anticipatory Bail application filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. Lakhan Sahni, 2. Sanjeet Sahni, 3. Lulsi Devi & 4. Anita Devi, who are apprehending his arrest in connection with Basudeopur P. S. Case No. 42/2026 registered U/S 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), (3), 3(5) of B.N.S. is put up for hearing today. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Addl.P.P. It is submitted on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioner has filed no any bail application either anticipatory or regular on behalf of the petitioner in any court or before this court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. In para 3 of petition, petitioner has one criminal antecedent i.e Kotwali P.S. Case No. 95/2022. It is further submitted on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent, he has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated. Therefore, it is prayed to grant the petitioner the privilege of anticipatory bail. Per contra learned Addl.P.P. opposed the anticipatory bail prayer of the petitioner. Heard both the parties and perused the case record, the case of prosecution as revealed from FIR, is that on 16.04.2026 at about 08:30 PM, informant namely Sunny Kumar was studying at his house then suddenly accused persons 1. Lakhan Sahni (Petitioner), 2. Nakul Kumar, 3. Bhim Kumar Sahni, 4. Sanjeet Sahni (Petitioner), 5. Abhishek Kumar, 6. Raja Sahni, 7. Surender Sahni, 8. Tulsi Devi (Petitioner), 9. Shanti Devi, 10 Anita Devi (Petitioner) entered into the informant house and started abusing & assaulted with Lathi-Danda

Lakhan Sahni and Raja Sahni hit on informant's head with the intention of killing him and Bhim Kumar Sahni slammed his sister on the ground with wrong intention and Abhishek Kumar also caught informant's Mausi with hair and caused her to fell down and kicked on her chest. Hence, this case is registered as Basudeopur P. S. Case No. 42/2026 U/S 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), (3), 3(5) of B.N.S. From perusal of the case record and case diary, It appears that the petitioners are named in FIR. Both sides are neighbours. The cause of the conflict is a land dispute between the both parties. There are many injured persons in both sides. It is submitted by Ld. APO that injury of Naina Devi & Anita Devi is not mentioned in case diary but Naina Devi is admitted in Jawaharlal Nehru Hospital, Bhagalpur in serious condition while Shanti Devi is treated at Ruban Hospital Patna. Considering the entire facts & circumstances of the case, and nature of the allegation and seriousness of the offence, this court does not think it is a fit case for granting anticipatory bail. Hence, the anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioners 1. Lakhan Sahni, 2. Sanjeet Sahni, 3. Lulsi Devi & 4. Anita Devi is hereby rejected. Dictated Addl.
