

In the court of Sessions Judge, Munger
Cr. Misc. No. 24/2026
Arising out of A.B.A No. 154/2024
Bindeshwari Yadav Vs. State of Bihar

1. The present Cr. Misc. petition has been preferred praying for extension of the order dated 30.01.2024 as passed by this Court in A.B.A. No. 154/2024.
2. The allegations against the petitioner is that he was illegally drawing electricity on account of which the Electricity Department suffered a loss of about Rs. 3,83,205/-. Hence the information based on which Harpur P.S. Case No. 13/2023 u/s 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003 was registered against the petitioner. That subsequently this Court vide order dated 30.01.2024 in A.B.A. No. 154/2024 had allowed the prayer for pre-arrest bail of the petitioner on his undertaking that he will deposit the abovestated loss amount to the Electricity Department in monthly installments of Rs. 30,000/- each till realisation.
3. The Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of poor financial condition and health issues the petitioner has been unable to deposit the stipulated loss amount to the Electricity Department and hence has failed to comply with the abovesaid order dated 30.01.2024 in A.B.A. No. 154/2024. That the petitioner is willing to deposit the loss amount of the F.I.R in six equated monthly installments and accordingly he has placed an affidavit on record. Hence, he pleads that the operation of the order dated 30.01.2024 in A.B.A. No. 154/2024 be accordingly extended.
4. The Ld. Counsel for the Electricity Department has opposed the prayer for bail and submits that as on date the total outstanding after adding the penal interest comes to about Rs. 5,67,143.40/-.
5. Heard the submissions of the respective Ld. Counsels and perused the affidavit as placed on record wherein the petitioner has undertaken to deposit the loss amount of the F.I.R. in six equated

monthly installments. Accordingly, the petitioner is hereby permitted to deposit the loss amount as per his affidavit and he is further directed to surrender before the learned Trial Court **after depositing the first installment** within 15 (Fifteen) days from the receipt / production of this order. That the other conditions laid down in order dated 30.01.2024 passed in A.B.A. No. 154/2024 shall remain intact.

6. The office is directed to send a copy of this order to the concerned Court immediately.
