Gyani Kumar and other Vs. The State of Bihar

1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioners

1. Gyani Kumar S/o- Ghosan Bind and **2. Palo Kumar**, s/o- Chandradeo Bind who are lying in judicial custody since 19.03.2026 in connection with Shampur P.S. Case No. 26/2026, u/ss 103(1), 3(5) of B.N.S, pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M. Ist, Munger.

2. The informant has alleged that all the accused persons including the petitioners murdered her son over a land dispute. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

3. At the outset the Id. Counsel for the petitioners has certified that previously no regular or anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioner No. 1 has one criminal case pending against him and the petitioner No. 2 has no criminal case pending against him.** The Ld. Counsel submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence and further that they have been falsely implicated in the present case. That the petitioners are lying in judicial custody since 19.03.2026. Therefore the Id. Counsel pleads that the petitioners be enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. P.P. has opposed the prayer of bail application of the petitioners and submits that the petitioners are the named accused of the F.I.R and the investigation in the case is continuing. That the witnesses in their respective statements on paras 8, 9 and 51 of the case diary have supported the prosecution case. From the post-mortem report, the doctor has opined the cause of death was due to 'Asphyxia, caused by hanging.'

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5. Heard the submissions of respective Id. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the case record it seems that the petitioners are the named accused of the F.I.R and the investigation in the case is continuing. That the witnesses in their respective statements on paras 8, 9 and 51 of the case diary have supported the prosecution case. From the post-mortem report, the doctor has opined the cause of death was due to 'Asphyxia, caused by hanging.' That the petitioners are lying in judicial custody since 19.03.2026.

7. Therefore, considering the seriousness and gravity of the offence, the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and the circumstances, I am not inclined to accept the present bail application and hence the same is hereby **Rejected**.
