1. Case called out.
2. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that an anticipatory bail application on behalf of the petitioner was provisionally allowed by this Court vide order dated 13.05.2026 passed in ABA No. 659/2026 with direction to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within 15 days of the order. He further submits that the Electricity Department refused to receive the fine amount as per your order resulting which he could not surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within the stipulated time. Therefore, it is prayed to extend the period of surrender before the Ld. Trial Court.
3. The Ld. P.P. raised no objection.
5. Heard both the sides. Perused the case record and order dated 13.05.2026 passed in ABA No. 659/2026.
6. Hence, considering the submissions of the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, the prayer is hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Ld.
