1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioner **Gholate Singh**, S/o- Sildhar Singh, who is lying in judicial custody since 26.04.2026 in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 371/2025 u/ss 126(2), 115(2) and 118(1) of B.N.S., pending in the Court of Ld. C.J.M., Munger.

2. The informant has alleged that all the accused persons including the petitioner abused and physically assaulted his father over a dispute with regard to a cow and when he came to save his father all the accused persons also assaulted him as a result of which they suffered injuries. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

3. At the outset the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has certified that previously two anticipatory bail applications filed on behalf of the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court vide order dated 08.04.2026 and 27.04.2026 in A.B.A. No. 324/2026 and 524/2026 and except this no any regular or anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioner has three criminal cases pending against him.** He further submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and further that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. That there are land disputes between the parties. That the present petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 26.04.2026. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the present petitioner be enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. P.P. has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioner and submits that the petitioner is a named accused of the F.I.R. and the investigation in the case is continuing. From the injury report, it appears that the victim has suffered injuries on the vital parts of the body which have been

opined to be grievous in nature.

5. Heard the submissions of respective Id. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the case record it seems that the petitioner is a named accused of the F.I.R. and the investigation in the case is continuing. From the injury report, it appears that the victim has suffered injuries on the vital parts of the body which have been opined to be grievous in nature. That the witnesses in their respective statements on paras 6, 7, 8 and 20 have supported the prosecution case. That the petitioner has three criminal cases pending against him as per para 3 of the present bail application. That the present petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 26.04.2026.

7. Hence, considering the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and the circumstances, I am not inclined to accept the present bail application and consequently the same is hereby **Rejected**.
