BAIL APPLICATION No.- 1033/2026

Rajeev Singh @ Rajiv Kumar @ Rajveer Singh Vs. The State of Bihar
Jamalpur P.S. Case No.-04/2024

1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioner Rajeev Singh @ Rajeev Kumar @ Rajveer Singh S/o-Rakesh Kumar, who is lying in judicial custody since 26.04.2026 in connection with Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 04/2024 u/s- 406, 420, 467, 468, 34 of BNS pending in the Court of Ms. Shalini Kiran, Ld. JMFC, Munger.

2. The informant has alleged that all accused persons has committed a fraud under a conspiracy with her. On dated 17.07.2023 absconding woman Sharda Devi (Sunita Sinha), other co-accused her husband Rakesh Kumar and her daughter Rajni Kumar, Manisha Sinha and son Rajveer Singh hatched a conspiracy and executed a fraud in the registry by cheating Rs. 21,50,000.

Hence the information, based on which the above stated Jamalpur P.S. case 04/2024 was registered.

3. At the outset the Id. Counsel for the petitioner has certified that previously no regular or anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioner has no criminal history**. He further submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and further that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. Further, in his oral submissions Ld. Counsel states that petitioner is ready to pay the amount with interest as directed by this Court which amounts to Rs. 2,48,000 (2 lacks principal and 48,000

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interest @ 8% per annum).

That the present petitioner is in judicial custody since 26.04.2025. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the present petitioner be enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. PP has opposed the bail application of the petitioner.

5. Heard the submissions of respective Id. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the case record, it appears that petitioner is named accused and he is in custody since-26.04.2026. Other co-accused has been granted bail in this case. There is no any criminal antecedent against this petitioner. Petitioner is ready to furnish the amount (i.e Rs.2,00,000) with interest which he has received in his account. Further, in his oral submissions Ld. Counsel states that petitioner will pay the amount with interest as directed by this Court which amounts to Rs. 2,48,000 (2 lacks principal and 48,000 interest @ 8% per annum). Four monthly installment of Rs.50,000 and last installment of Rs. 48,000.

7. Accordingly, considering the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and the circumstances, this bail application is hereby **provisionally Allowed**. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the

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satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court **with conditions that one of the bailors shall be family member of the petitioner and that the petitioner shall file an undertaking that he will not tamper with any of the evidences or influence any of the witnesses of the case and that he shall remain physically present before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every date. Petitioner will also file undertaking that total amount will be paid in five monthly installments.**

Bail bond of the petitioner shall be confirmed after complete payment of total amount of Rs. 2,48,000 in the petitioner's Account no.-922010033300517.
