Chhanguri Mandal and others Vs. The State of Bihar
Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 210/2024

1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioners **1. Chhanguri Mandal, 2. Rohit Mandal** and **3. Dhananjay Mandal**, all S/o-Paro Mandal, who are lying in judicial custody since 25.04.2026 and 29.04.2026 respectively in connection with Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 210/2024, u/s 191(2), 191(3), 126(2), 115(2), 109, 103(1) of B.N.S., pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-II, Munger.

2. The informant has alleged that on 23.09.2024 at about 04:30 PM, all the F.I.R. named accused persons including the petitioners assaulted him, his brother and father with iron rod and lathi as a result of which they suffered injuries. Further all the injured were referred to Mayaganj Hospital, Bhagalpur from where informant's brother namely Adarsh Kumar referred to Forthhill Hospital, Silliguri where he died during the treatment. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

3. At the outset the Id. Counsel for the petitioners has certified that previously an anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the petitioners was rejected by this Court vide order dated 12.12.2024 in A.B.A. No. 1763/2024. Thereafter the petitioners preferred an anticipatory bail application before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna which was also rejected vide order dated 20.02.2025 in Cr. Misc. No. 4194/2025. Further the petitioner No. 2 again preferred an anticipatory bail application before this Court which was also rejected vide order dated 29.07.2025 in A.B.A. No. 805/2025 and the anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the petitioners No. 1 and 3 was also dismissed by this Court vide orders dated 22.08.2025 in A.B.A. No. 1224/2025. Thereafter, the petitioners have again filed two separate anticipatory bail applications before

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the Hon'ble High Court which were dismissed as not maintainable vide orders dates 12.12.2025 and 05.02.2026 in Cr. Misc. Nos. 68429/2025 and 75435/2025 respectively. Again the petitioners preferred a regular bail application before this Court which was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court vide order dated 26.05.2026 in B.A No. 999/2026. That except these no any other regular or anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioners No. 1 and 3 have one criminal case pending against them and petitioner no. 2 has no criminal case pending against him.** The Ld. Counsel submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence and further that they have been falsely implicated in the present case. That there are land dispute between the parties. That there are no specific allegations against the petitioners. That there is an unexplained inordinate delay of four days in lodging the F.I.R. That some of the co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail as well as regular bail by Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide orders dated 19.02.2025, 02.05.2025 and 29.07.2025 in Cr. Misc No. 3568/2025, Cr. Misc No. 23673/2025 and Cr. Misc. No. 24473/2025 respectively. That the petitioners are lying in judicial custody since 25.04.2026 & 29.04.2026 respectively. Therefore the ld. Counsel pleads that the petitioners be enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. PP has opposed the bail application of the petitioners and submit that the petitioners are the named accused of the F.I.R and the investigation in the case is continuing. From the post-mortem report, the doctor has opined the cause of death was due to "the effects of head injury, antemortem in nature". That the Hon'ble High Court, Patna has twice rejected the

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anticipatory bail applications filed on behalf of the petitioners vide orders dated 20.02.2025, 12.12.2025 and 05.02.2026 in Cr. Misc. No. 4194/2025, 68429/2025 and 75435/2025 respectively.

5. Heard the submissions of respective ld. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the case record, it seems that petitioners are the named accused of the F.I.R. That the witnesses in their respective statements on paras 6, 7 and 14 of the case diary have fully supported the prosecution case. From the postmortem report of deceased Adarsh Kumar it seems that as per the opinion of the doctor the death was due to “the effects of head injury, antemortem in nature”. That the investigation in the case is continuing. That the Hon’ble High Court, Patna has twice rejected the anticipatory bail applications filed on behalf of the petitioners vide orders dated 20.02.2025, 12.12.2025 and 05.02.2026 in Cr. Misc. Nos. 4194/2025, 68429/2025 and 75435/2025 respectively. That the petitioners are lying in judicial custody since 25.04.2026 and 29.04.2026 respectively.

7. Therefore, considering the seriousness and gravity of the offence, the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and the circumstances, I am not inclined to accept the present bail application and hence the same is hereby **Rejected**.
