Shyam Shankar Singh Vs. The State of Bihar

Kharagpur P.S. Case No.-93/2024

12.06.2026

1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioner Shyam Shankar Singh S/o- Siya Ram Singh, who is in judicial custody since 14.05.2026 in connection with Kharagpur P.S. Case No.-93/2024 u/s- 147/148/149/307/354/452/323/379/34 of IPC pending in the Court of Ld. ACJM-I, Munger.

2. The informant has alleged(as per FIR) that on dated- 21.01.2026 during the day accused persons with intention to forcibly grab the ancestral land, started erecting a fence with Khutta and barbed wire. When informant refused to allow this, Shyam Singh enraged with anger, ordered to beat and kill informant's brother. Immediately upon receiving the order, Shyam Shankar Singh, with intention to kill struck informant's brother on the head with an iron spade(Khanti) held in their hand. Chandrika Singh struck Prabhu Shankar Singh on the head with iron spade, and Chhotu Singh struck Vikas on the head with an iron spade held in his hand. Due to this, the heads of informant's brothers split open and they fell down, bleeding profusely. When informant ran to save his brother accused Siyarma Singh and Uma Shankar Singh, both struck on the head of informant with iron spade. However, when informant fell down in an attempt to save his life, all the blows landed on the informant's shoulder, hand, and body. The villagers witnessed the incident. Accused threatened that no one will be left to perform your last rites. Upon seeing the neighbors gather due to the commotion, the accused fled away while again threatening to kill.

Hence the information, based on which the above stated Kharagpur P.S.

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Case No.-93/2024 u/s- 147/148/149/307/354/452/323/379/34 of IPC was registered.

3. At the outset the Id. Counsel for the petitioner has certified that previously ABA No.-467/2025 has been rejected by this Court & Cr. Misc.-74863/2025 has also dismissed by Hon'ble High Court Patna, except that no regular or anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioner has one criminal history in which he is on bail**. He further submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and further that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. Ld. Counsel

for the petitioner has submitted that falsity of the case itself appeared from perusal of the complainant case that the instant complaint case has been filed lated lapse of nine days by obtaining a false injury report. The dispute arose between the parties for ancestral property for which wordy duel arose and local police initiated a proceeding U/S 107 Cr.P.C on both parties. That the present petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.05.2026. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the present petitioner be enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. APP & Ld. Counsel for the informant opposed the bail application of the petitioner and further he has made wrong submission in para-3 of bail petition, that he is on bail in Kharagpur P.S Case No.- 248/2018 while actually he is not on bail in above case.

5. Heard the submissions of respective Id. Counsels and perused

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the record of the case.

6. Perused the case record, it found that petitioner is named accused, allegation against this petitioner is to forcibly grab the ancestral land and assaulting the informant's brother on his vital part of body i.e head. As per para-51 of the case diary nature of injury is grievous caused by hard and blunt substance. Ld. Counsel of petitioner makes wrong submission in para-3 of the bail petition that he is on bail in Kharagpur P.S. 248/2018 while he is not on bail in this case. It appears that petitioner is trying to mislead the Court.

7. Therefore, considering the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and the circumstances, this Court is not inclined to accept the present bail application and consequently the same is hereby **Rejected**.
