Kalicharan Bind @ Kaliya Vs. The State of Bihar
Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 66/2021

1. The present bail application has been preferred by petitioner **Kalicharan Bind @ Kaliya**, S/o- Bishwanath Bind, who is lying in judicial custody since 10.02.2026 in connection with Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 66/2021 u/s 147, 149, 341, 323, 307 and 504 of I.P.C. and section 27 of Arms Act, pending in the Court of the Ld. A.C.J.M-II, Munger.

2. The informant has alleged that all the accused persons including the petitioner abused and assaulted him and his family members over a land dispute. He further alleged that the co-accused Amar Kumar with an intention to kill fired a gun shot upon informant's son as a result of which he suffered bullet injuries. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

3. At the outset the Id. Counsel for the petitioner has certified that previously no anticipatory or regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioner has three criminal case pending against him**. He further submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and further that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. That there are no specific allegations against the petitioner. That some of the co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 16.08.2021 and 25.09.2025 in B.A. No. 1085/2021 and 2098/2025. That no case u/s 307 of IPC and 27 of Arms Act is made out against the petitioner. That the present petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 10.02.2026. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the present petitioner be enlarged on bail.

4. The Ld. PP has opposed the bail application of the petitioner.

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5. Heard the submissions of respective Id. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the case record, it appears that the cognizance in the case has already been taken by the Ld. Trial Court. That there are no specific allegations of firing against the petitioner. From the injury report, it is apparent that the injuries are simple in nature. That some of the co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 16.08.2021 and 25.09.2025 in B.A. No. 1085/2021 and 2098/2025. That the present petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 10.02.2026.

7. Hence, considering the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and the circumstances, this bail application is hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court **with conditions that one of the bailors shall be family member of the petitioner and that the petitioner shall file an undertaking that he will not tamper with any of the evidences or influence any of the witnesses of the case and that he shall remain physically present before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every date.**
