ANTICIPATORY BAIL APPLICATION No.- 748/2026

1. A petition dated 08.06.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner No. **2 namely Karu Das** seeking permission to withdraw his anticipatory bail application, in connection with Gangta P.S. Case No. 53/2023.
2. The Ld. Counsel submits that the petitioner wants to withdraw his anticipatory bail application, hence he may be permitted to withdraw the same.
3. The Ld. P.P. raised no objection.
4. Heard. Perused the petition dated 08.06.2026
5. Prayer is **Allowed**. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application with respect to Petitioner No. **2 namely Karu Das** is **Dismissed as Withdrawn** as prayed for.
6. Put up for hearing for the rest petitioner.

1. The present anticipatory bail application has been preferred by petitioners **1. Shamanand Das**, s/o- Chhatu Das, **3. Diwakar Das**, s/o- Braj Kishore Das, **4. Nityanand Das**, s/o- Sundar Das, **5. Arvind Das**, s/o- Panchanand Das, **6. Rajiv Das**, S/o- Sudin Das and **7. Panchanand Das**, S/o- Chhatu Das who are apprehending arrest in connection with Gangta P.S. Case No. 53/2023, u/ss 341, 323, 308, 504, 506/34, of IPC pending in the Court Ms. Kiran Kumari., Ld. J.M-Ist class, Munger.

2. The informant has alleged that all the accused persons including the petitioners abused and assaulted him as well as his family member as a result of which his aunt suffered injuries. Hence the information, based on which the above stated P.S. case was registered.

3. At the outset the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners has certified that previously no anticipatory or regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners before this Court or before any other Court including the Hon'ble High Court. He also certified that **the petitioners have no criminal cases pending against them.** The Ld. Counsel submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence and further that they have been falsely implicated in the present case. That the police has already granted the benefit of section 41(1) of Cr.P.C. to the petitioners. That the cognizance in the case has been taken by the Ld. Trial Court. That no case u/s 308 of IPC is made out against the petitioners. Therefore the Ld Counsel pleads that the petitioners be granted the privilege of pre-arrest bail.

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4. The Ld. P.P. has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

5. Heard the submissions of respective ld. Counsels and perused the record of the case.

6. From perusal of the case record it seems that the cognizance in the case has already been taken by the Ld. Trial Court. That the police has already granted the benefit of section 41(1) of Cr.P.C. to the petitioners. From the injury report it is apparent that injuries are simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. That the petitioners have no criminal case pending against them as per para 3 of the present anticipatory bail application.

7. Hence, considering the nature of allegations and in the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail application is hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within 15 days from the date of communication of this order, the petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court subject to the conditions as laid down U/S 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
