The present Anticipatory Bail Application has been preferred by Petitioners namely, **(1) Ajit Kumar Paswan** s/o Dileshwar Paswan and **(2) Poonam Devi** w/o Ajit Kumar Paswan who are apprehension of arrest in connection with Laraiyatarn P.S. Case No. 61 of 2026 under Sections 87, 115(2) & 352 of BNS, pending in the Court of Ld. C.J.M., Munger. Learned Counsel for the Petitioners' is present and Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State is also present.

As per the Bail Application, it is submitted that the Petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence and falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the Petitioners are parents of main accused person who is a minor and has entered into a marriage with another minor girl following a love affairs. The Petitioners are man of means of society. In para-2 of the Application, it is certified that the Petitioners have not previously filed any type of bail application before this Court or before Hon'ble High Court of Patna. The Petitioners have no criminal antecedent except the electricity Act Harput P.S. Case No. 25 of 2022. The Petitioners are ready to furnish the bail bond and they are also ready to comply with direction of this Court. Hence, it is prayed to enlarge the Petitioners on Anticipatory Bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State as well as Ld. Counsel for the Informant vehemently opposed the present Bail Application.

As per the written statement of the Informant, the case of the prosecution is that the Informant namely Shashibhushan Kumar alleged that Raghuvir Paswan has kidnapped his minor daughter on the pretext of marriage. He further

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alleged that the Informant went to the house of Raghuvir Paswan's parents for complaint but father of accused namely Ajit Kumar Paswan (Petitioner) and mother namely Poonam Devi started to abuse and stated that not to return his daughter and threatened him. The informant further alleged that the Raghuvir Paswan and his parents are kidnapped his minor daughter.

Heard both sides and perused the case record.

From perusal of the case records, it is clear that the Petitioners are named in FIR and there is direct allegation against the Petitioners to help the main accused person who is his parents in kidnapping minor daughter of Informant and used abusive words. All prosecution witnesses in paras-2 & 10 of the case diary have supported the case of prosecution. Paras-86 & 96 of the case diary contained statements of victim under Sections 180 & 183 of BNSS in which she has claimed that she has voluntarily married with Raghuvir Paswan and no one has kidnapped and she further claimed that she is pregnant about two months as well as she is living with her parents house. The victim has given her statement under Section 180 of BNSS (para-86 of case diary) and has stated that the parents of Raghuvir Paswan have brought her to live together in Sahibabad (UP) and they lived together there and later on, they (Petitioners) brought her to Bihar due to her search by her father which shows their active involvement in this case. Para-78 of case diary also reflect that brother of main accused namely Karamveer Kumar has stated that his parents along with victim and Raghuvir Paswan were living there and moved to Bihar due to search of father of victim. From perusal of the case records, it also appears that the main accused person namely Raghuvir Paswan has voluntarily surrendered before Ld. J.J.B., Munger on 22.06.2026 since then he is in protective custody. Ld. Counsel for the Informant present along with Informant and victim and the Informant has also

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claimed that her minor daughter is pregnant about two months. This case is still under investigation.

Therefore, considering aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as discussed above, nature of the allegation, present status of this case, the allegation against the petitioners regarding their actively involvement in this case, statement of victim under Section 180 of BNSS as well as the fact that the victim is pregnant, I am of the view that there is direct allegation against the Petitioners to help the main accused person who is also their son in concealment of victim and actively involved in this case which is serious in nature and the Petitioners are parents of main accused person. Hence, the Petitioners do not deserve privilege of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer of bail of the petitioners namely **Ajit Kumar Paswan and Poonam Devi** is hereby **Rejected**.
