18.03.2026 Petition for bail filed U/s 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of above named
petitioners apprehending their arrest U/Ss. 115(2), 126(2), 303(2), 109(1),
351(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S. in connection with Kumarband P.S. Case No.
246/2025, pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Shambhu Yadav, learned lawyer for the petitioners as
well as Sri Naresh Sharma, learned lawyer for the informant and Sri Bibeka
Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

As per written-report of informant Dharendra Prasad Yadav,
allegation against the accused persons, including the petitioners are that they
brutally assaulted the informant and his nephew Aman Kumar causing injury.
There is also allegation of pulling Gamchi by putting around the neck of
informant by Deepak Kumar and Birendra Kumar. There is also allegation of
snatching gold-chain from the neck of informant by petitioner Nitish Kumar
and co-accused Ranjan Yadav.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted
that the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in the
present case. It is also submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation of
assaulting and snatching against the petitioners. The petitioners have got no
criminal antecedent at all. Moreover, now the good-sense have been prevailed
between the parties and the compromise petition with permission petition duly
signed of both the sides has been filed on behalf of informant/injured.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of informant and learned P.P. appearing on behalf of State conceded that the parties have entered into a compromise.


Perused the record. It appears that there is no specific allegation

of assault or snatching against the petitioners. From perusal of injury-report, it appears that the doctor has found the injury on the persons of injured Dharendra Prasad Yadav & Aman Kumar, simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance (vide para-77). The parties have entered into a compromise. The informant/injured appeared in persons in the court and supported the factum of compromise. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent except the present case, which is evident from para-52 of case diary.

In view of aforesaid facts, prayer of above named petitioners is

allowed and they are directed to be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within 15 days from the date of receipt a copy of this order/production before the learned court below, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below in connection with Kumarhand P.S. Case No. 246/2025, subject to condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.
